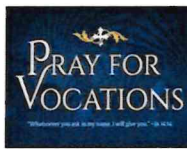
PCCW Mother's Day Weekend Carnation Sale

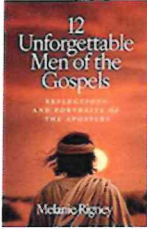
