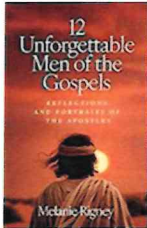

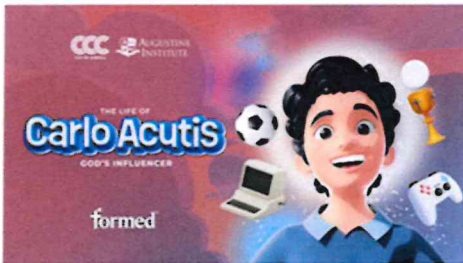
Faith Sharing Group

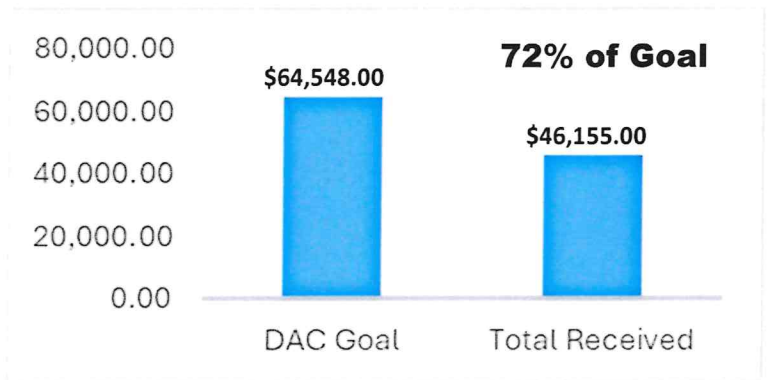
