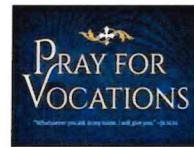

**SAINT SPOTLIGHT St. Maria Goretti**

Born: October 16, 1890 Corinaldo, Italy

Died; July 6, 1902 Nettuno, Italy

St. Maria Goretti is the youngest saint to be canonized. At 9 years old her father died leaving Maria to help her mother to raise her 5 siblings and help with the house and to clean and cook for her neighbors. The neighbor's son, Alessandro made inappropriate comments causing her to retreat. Later when she was 11 years old, he made physical advances at Maria, trying to rape her. She fought and faltered his sexual attempt but he ended up stabbing her multiple times. St. Maria died from her wounds the next day. Her last words were, " I forgive Allesandro Serenelli... and I want him in heaven with me forever."
