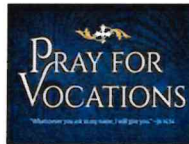

AUGUST 6TH

The Transfiguration is described in detail in the Synoptic Gospels: **Matthew 17:1-8, Mark 9:2-8, and Luke 9:28-36**. In this event, Jesus takes Peter, James, and John to a high mountain (Many believe Mount

Tabor), where He is transfigured before them. His face shines like the sun, and His clothes become dazzling white.
