PART A- UNDERSTANDING AND ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF RISK

I, the undersigned registrant understands and acknowledge:

- That the activity I am participating in may be of a hazardous nature and may include physical and/or strenuous activity.
- Serious incidents may occur during said activity, and participants in said activity may sustain personal injuries. I understand that there is a possibility of personal risk, damage, or injury to myself and assume responsibility for those risks as a condition of registering for Extended Learning Programs at Nipissing University. Nipissing University's liability for any injury or loss is excluded by the terms and conditions of Nipissing University's release of liability.
- That part of the **risk involved** in undertaking any activity or program is relative to one's own state of fitness or health (physical, mental, or emotional) and the awareness, care, and skill with which I conduct myself in that activity or program.
- That I am in satisfactory physical and mental condition to safely participate in the said activity.
- That I am competent to agree to this document and that I have read and understand this document.
- That I **am free to withdraw from program activities at any time**, and that if I am unable to participate fully that it is my responsibility to withhold my attendance.
- That I have **been given the opportunity to inquire about the nature of any activity**, program, or services that I am not completely familiar with, and I have been informed of any inherent risks and that all activities will take place in North Bay, ON.

PART B- HEATH POLICY

I, the undersigned registrant understands and acknowledge Nipissing University's policy on the important measures to take to prevent the spread of respiratory illnesses such as influenza, Covid and common colds on campus.
