

1,383 parishioners supported our parish financially, which funded Bible studies, grief and funeral ministries, catechesis and evangelization programs, parish staff and more.



Worshipping

We are a Eucharistic people, representing many cultures, united by the love of our Lord, Jesus Christ.

Last year, together we spent over 365 hours in Eucharistic adoration. We celebrated Mass together over 480 times.

We welcomed hundreds of visitors from the wider community to join us at Lenten, Easter, and Christmas Masses.



We are a generous community, giving of our time and our talents, and preaching the gospel through our actions.

Last year, we cared for our wider community through two youth and adult mission trips and multiple service days in collaboration with community partners like Nativity House, Agape Service Project, and Esperanza International.

We shared the gospel and provided hospitality to our neighbors through Alpha Course, which welcomed over 100 participants.

Our parish freely provided 36 funerals for grieving families, conducted 237 Catholic prayer services for those in prison, and anointed the sick 408 times. We brought Holy Communion to 115 homebound parishioners every week.

Growing

The Holy Spirit is drawing people closer to God through St. Vincent de Paul Parish!

Last year,

- 116 new families joined our parish.
- 17 people joined the Catholic Faith through OCIA.
- 10 couples were married.
- 78 people received First Holy Communion.
- 70 people were confirmed.
- 121 people were baptized.

I'm pleased to present the annual reports for our St. Vincent de Paul parish and school!


