

Satellite Dish Rules & Regulations

(Must be signed even if you do not plan on installing satellite dish)

The Federal Communications Commission (FCC) issued a rule that allows residents to install satellite dishes. This rule went into effect on 1/22/1999 (Over-the-air reception devices rules).

You may not have a satellite dish installed on the property without notifying the AM Management office beforehand.

We have a contract with Big Dog Satellite for sales and installations at this property, therefore they are the only company that you are allowed to receive service through for your satellite dish needs. All satellite dishes must be professionally installed by Big Dog Satellite. You may not install your dish yourself.

You are required to contact Big Dog Satellite for purchase of your satellite and they will do the installation free of charge. They install both DirecTV and Dish Network. They match the corporate prices including specials offered by both companies.

If you currently have satellite service at your previous location and you are interested in continuing that service you will still need to contact Big Dog Satellite.

Fees may apply for switching your services to your new AM Management location. Tenant is responsible for all additional fees.

If you should fail to follow the above guidelines you will incur a \$100 fee as well as your satellite dish being removed from the property at your expense.
