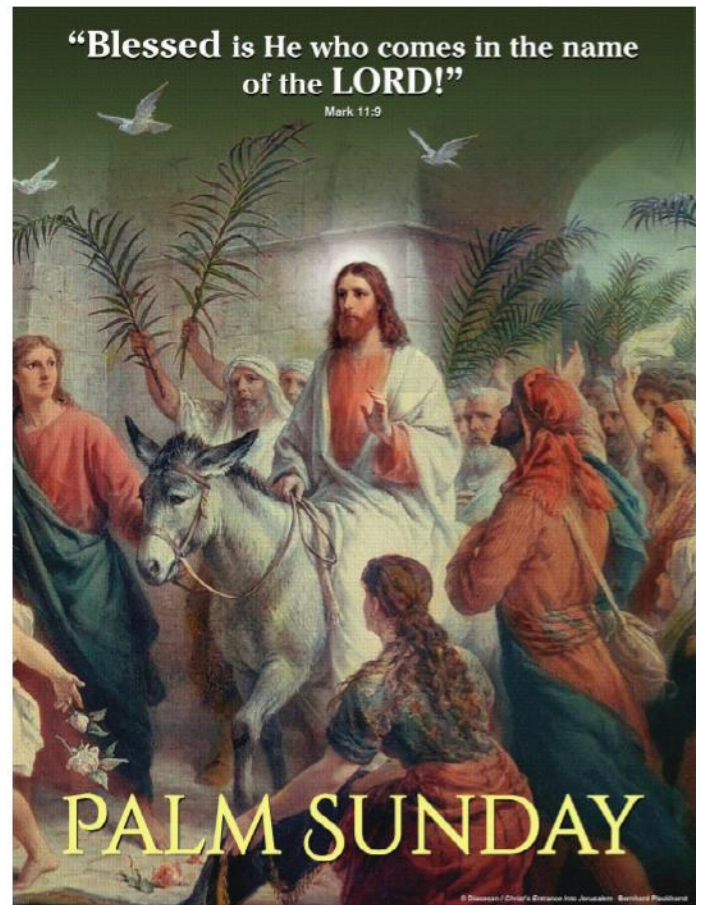

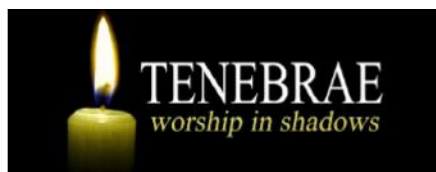

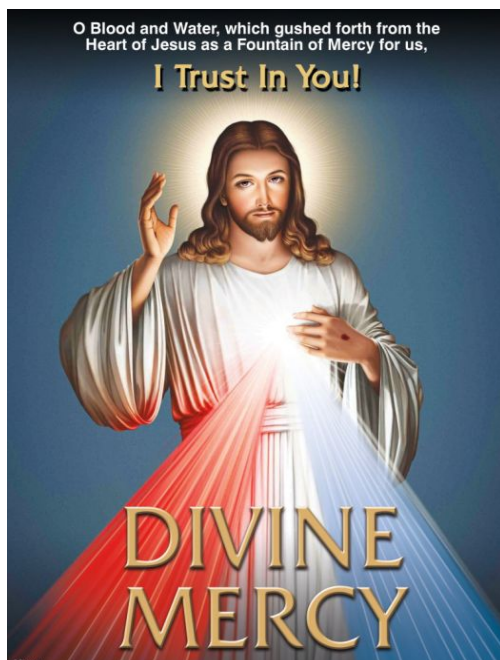

# HOLY WEEK EXPLAINED



**Palm Sunday** is the Christian moveable feast that falls on the Sunday before Easter. The feast commemorates Christ's triumphal entry into Jerusalem, an event mentioned in each of the four canonical Gospels. Its name originates from the palm branches waved by the crowd to greet and honor Jesus as he entered the city



On **Good Friday** we commemorate the crucifixion of Jesus Christ. Traditionally, there is no celebration of the Eucharist on Good Friday. A liturgy that focuses on the reading of the passion of Christ is celebrated. That will be followed by the veneration of the cross and later the faithful participate in the Holy Communion. Good Friday is a day of fasting. At St. Sebastian after the celebration of the Passion around 7.00 pm we will have living Stations.



**Spy Wednesday.** Traditionally the Wednesday of the Holy week is known as Spy Wednesday since this is the day on which Judas betrayed Jesus to the Sanhedrin. On Wednesday of the Holy week, at St. Sebastian we celebrate the Liturgy of Tenebrae. 'Tenebrae' means darkness or shadows. There are seven readings. After each reading the reader will put out a candle at the altar. It will be followed by the psalm sung by the choir and the prayer by the presider. After the seventh reading and when the last candle is put out, the congregation remains or leaves the church in silence.



**Holy Saturday** is the last day of Holy Week and ends the season of Lent. It is also known as the Vigil of Easter. Celebration of the Easter Vigil begins only after the sunset. During the Easter Vigil the faithful renew their baptismal promises and those who come to Christian Faith are accepted into the church with the sacraments of initiation, Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist.



**Holy Thursday** is the commemoration of the Last Supper of Jesus Christ, when he established the sacrament of Holy Eucharist prior to his arrest and crucifixion. It also commemorates the institution of the priesthood. Jesus celebrated the dinner as a Passover feast. This event is celebrated at every Mass, as part of the Liturgy of the Eucharist, but it is specially commemorated on Holy Thursday with the washing of the feet. After the celebration of the Mass, the tabernacle will be left empty and the remaining Eucharist will be carried in a Eucharistic procession which will be followed by adoration at LeSage Hall until 10:00 pm.

**In some cultures there is a tradition of Blessing the food in order to break the Lenten Fast.** At St. Sebastian blessing of the food will take place at 10:00 am..



**Easter Sunday** or Easter Day is the most important day of the year for Christians. It is when they celebrate that three days after being killed, Jesus rose from the dead, sometimes called 'the Resurrection' and defeated evil forever.

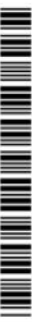
