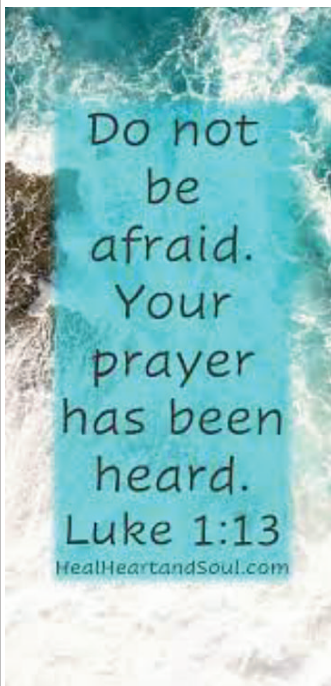
St. Sebastian welcomes

They are engaged in a diversity of ministries. Their efforts are very much concentrated in the areas of basic formation and training for the priesthood and religious life; primary evangelization in rural parts of Africa; on-going Christian formation in the faith through parish ministries; ministry among the Muslims; social justice ministries, and health care delivery; chaplaincies and education ministries at all levels. Seventeenth Sunday in Ordinary Time Be Careful What You Ask For



Jesus talks about praying for whatever we need with faith and confidence, but he ends by asking, “How much more with the Father . . . give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him?” (Luke 1:13). Is he saying there are limits to what we can ask for?

“Be careful what you ask for,” the saying warns. Just because we want something doesn’t mean it will be good for us. But if we have enough faith to pray for something, we probably would not pray for anything evil. So what is Jesus really saying? He is giving us two lessons about prayer.

First, he assures us that God does hear our prayers and answers them. Many people take “ask and you shall receive” so literally that they expect God to do their bidding no matter what they want. But God is free to do what is best for us, free to answer some prayers with a no when what we seek is against God’s will. So maybe our first prayer should be to ask God to show us what we really need.

That leads us to the second lesson: prayer changes us, not God. If we truly pray as Jesus prayed, we would say, “Not as I will, but as you will” (Matthew 26:39). It’s not easy to change our minds about what we want or need. To change our desires from selfish to holy takes a lot of power, the power of the Holy Spirit. Jesus was raised from the dead by that power and we will be, too (Romans 8:11). So when Jesus promises that the Father will give the Spirit to us for asking, the Spirit is both the source of and the answer to our prayers. Let us ask the Spirit to empower us

to desire and pray for what we really need.

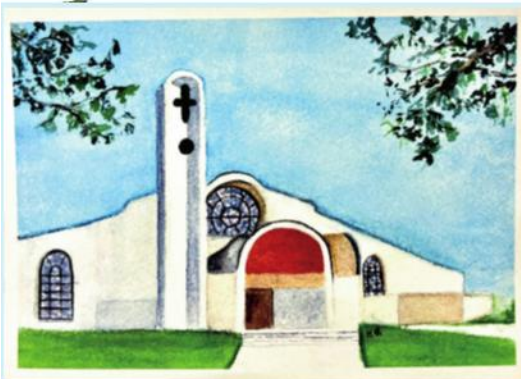


Diocese of Palm Beach's Commitment to the Protection of Minors and Vulnerable Adults:

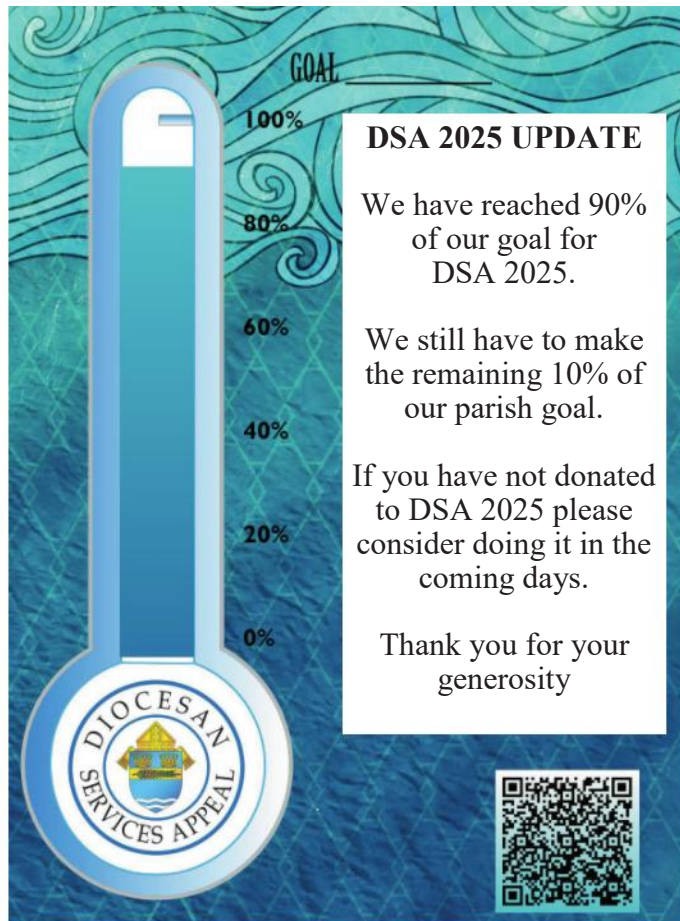

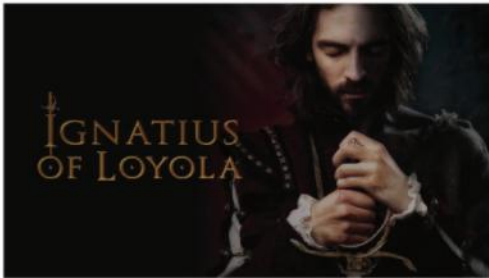

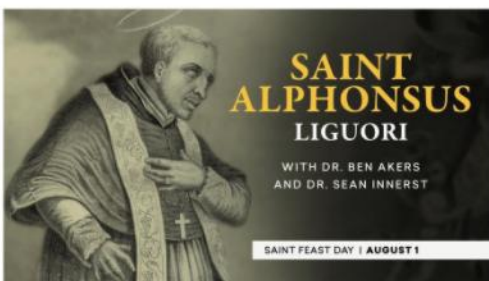
The Violinist: Stories of Solanus Casey

"Christ Renews Us" (CRU) is a one-day parish retreat, open to every adult member (age 21+) of St. Sebastian Catholic Community (including non-Catholic spouses, etc.) where you will experience a personal, spiritual renewal and an abundance of joy in Christian Community. CRU is a process designed to bring members of our parish together in Christ. It consists of two gifts. The first is a 'gift' of the day to you where you "come away" from the everyday world for a time of listening, sharing, prayer, fun and food! The second is your 'gift' to others where you simply take your renewed heart into your everyday life.

The retreat, is given by a team of Parishioners, like you, along with a Priest/Deacon who have come together to prepare this 'gift' for you. Men and women attend separate weekends. This is not a silent retreat. The emphasis is on personal and community renewal. The process is centered on the sharing of God's love by members of the Team and table sharing in a liturgical, scriptural, prayerful & casual atmosphere. There will be no pressure on you to talk or share. Sensitivity to you and your needs will always be respected.

The renewal process does not come on like a tornado! It brings God's message of love into finer focus and allows you a relaxed atmosphere to respond to Christ's call to a closer and deeper relationship with Him and other members of our parish.

This is an 'on-site' retreat offered in the Fall and Spring. It begins on a Friday evening and concludes on Saturday evening. All meals are prepared for you. If you have special dietary or other requirements, we will accommodate you. Please specify them on the Reservation Form. The retreat is informal. Casual and comfortable clothing will be the 'uniform of the day'!

Can you afford this? Absolutely "YES!" While the process attempts to be self-sustaining, we ask that you do not stay away for financial reasons. Donations at the end of the weekend are welcomed and always kept private and anonymous.
