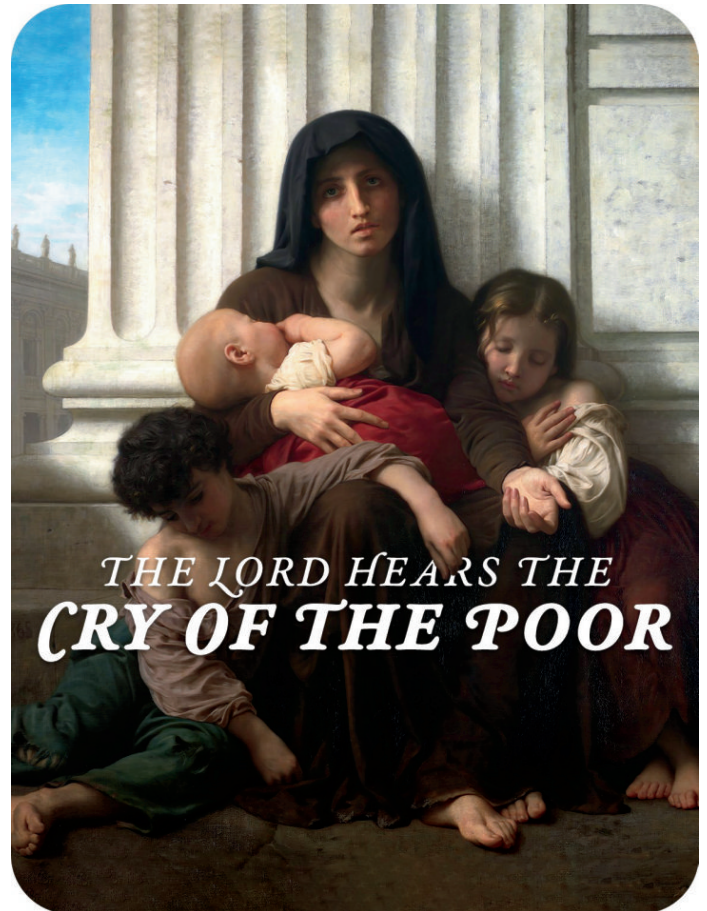

JACOB'S LADDER 2025

As a way of keeping our deceased loved ones in our thoughts and prayers throughout the month of November, month of all the souls, as in the past years, we will set up a "JACOB'S LADDER" at the narthex of the church.

Jacob's Ladder is a concept from a biblical dream where Jacob saw a ladder connecting the earth and heaven with angels ascending and descending. The concept symbolizes a divine connection between God and humanity, representing God's promises to Jacob and the establishment of the Israelites as his chosen people. It also signifies a bridge between the earthly and heavenly realms and is interpreted as a metaphor for the communion of saints both deceased and living.

All are invited to bring in and place small framed photographs of your deceased family and friends on it, as a way remembering them and praying for them. Jacob's ladder will stay in the narthex though out the month of November.

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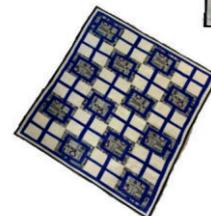

Please give what you can afford.
We will go by the first letter of your last name.

A-B-C: cereal, canned meats, tuna, canned stew, cranberry sauce, stuffing mix, peanut butter, jelly or jam, canned vegetables, pasta, pasta sauce.

D-E-F-G: stuffing mix, vegetable oil, hamburger helper, soup, boxed potatoes, cereal, canned meats, Jell-O, cookies, canned vegetables and rice.

H-I-J-K-L: canned fruit, stuffing mix, canned vegetables, boxed potatoes, gravy, soup, macaroni and cheese, tuna, cookies, pasta, pasta sauce, rice.

M-N-O-P-Q-R: canned fruit, hamburger helper, rice, pasta, pasta sauce, tuna, boxed potatoes, soup, mac and cheese, cookies, vegetable oil.

S-T-U-V: peanut butter, jelly or jam, cranberry sauce, boxed potatoes, gravy, soup, canned meats, cereal, canned vegetables, pasta and pasta sauce.

W-X-Y-Z: canned meats, tuna, canned stew, cranberry sauce, peanut butter, jelly or jam, cereal, canned vegetables, stuffing mix, rice and cookies.

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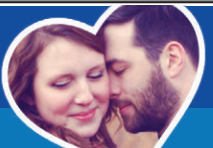
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
