

Dear Faith Family of St. Sebastian,

Greetings of Peace.

I have completed two years of ministry as your pastor and together we have labored for His greater glory and for His kingdom. It is an honor for me to be one among you, as a member of our amazing, welcoming and caring Faith Family of St. Sebastian.

Together with our Finance council, pastoral council and staff we have evaluated the health of our financial status. Thanks be to God and to you, we are doing well, and we can continue with all our ministries.

But just like every family out there, our Faith Family also feels the effects of inflation and increase of prices of goods and services. On our part we also have the responsibility to keep up with the COLA increase of our parish staff, so that they too can weather the storms of inflation and price increases.

At this juncture the Holy Spirit is nudging me to ask you to reconsider your giving to St. Sebastian. We all are creatures of habits, until someone makes us re-examine what we do and the way we do it. 
