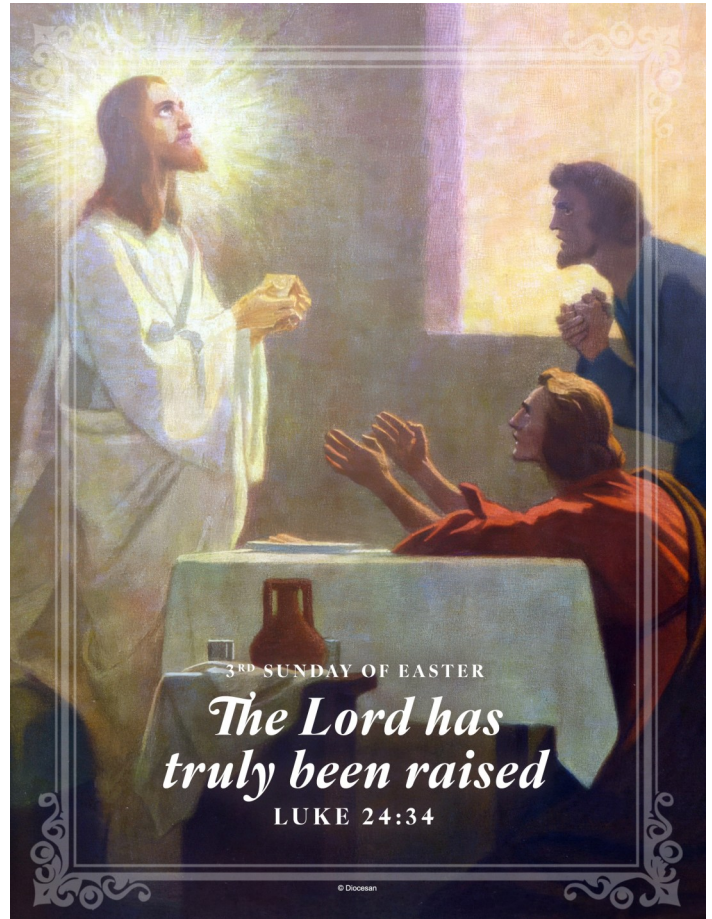

Join us for a fascinating and faith-enriching talk by Dr. Gilbert Lavoie, internationally known speaker and author of *The Shroud of Jesus*.

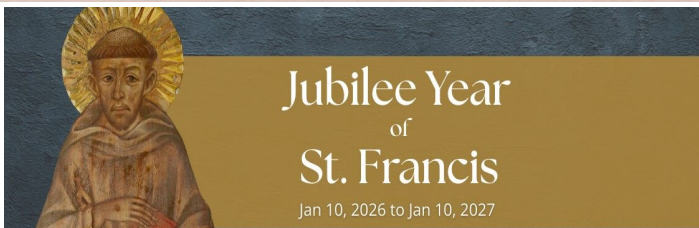
