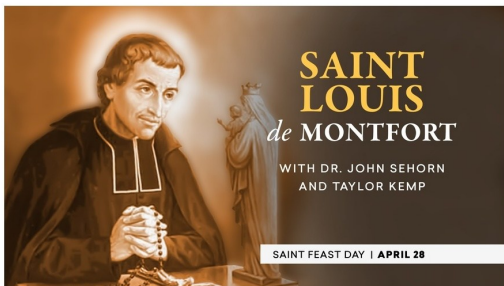
Joseph of Nazareth
