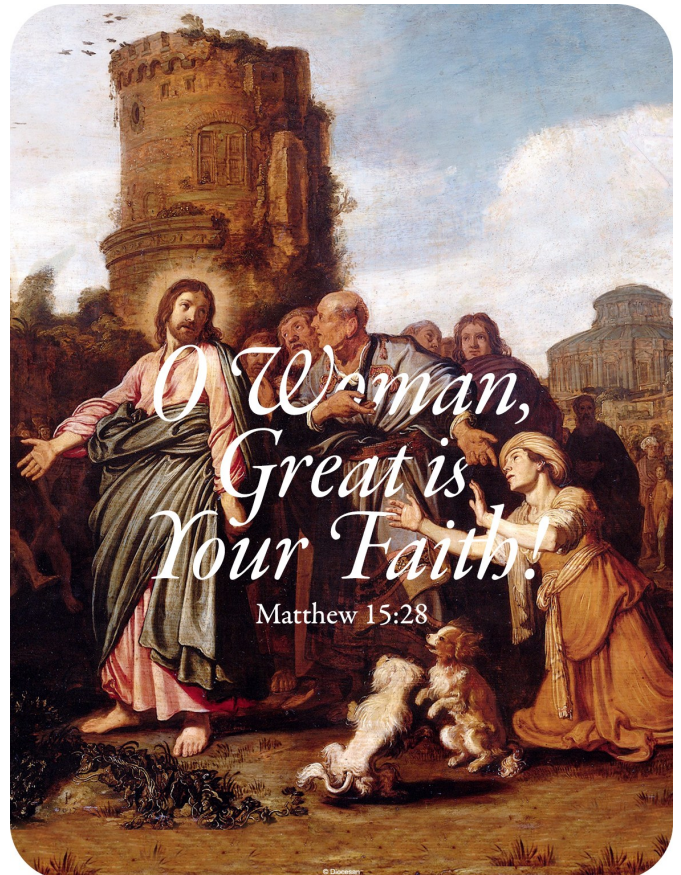

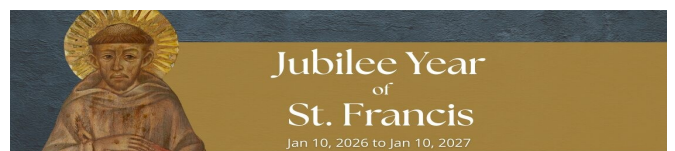
Welcome

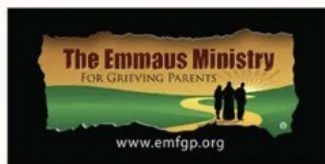

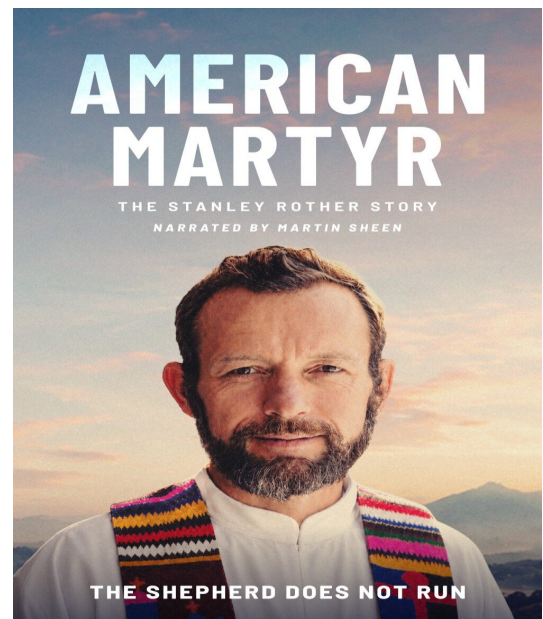

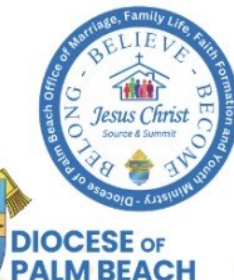
