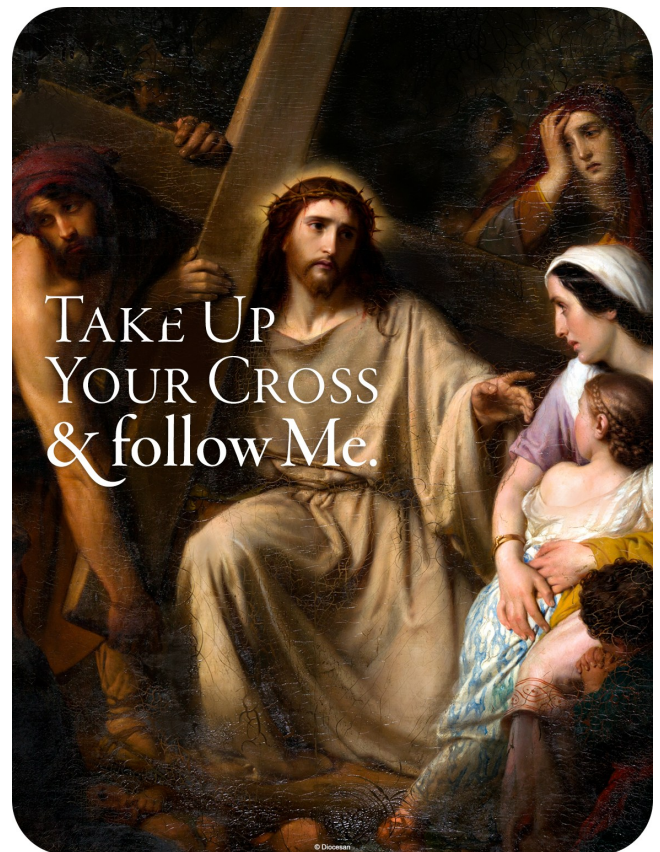

THE ORDER OF CHRISTIAN INITIATION OF ADULTS- OCIA INQUIRY



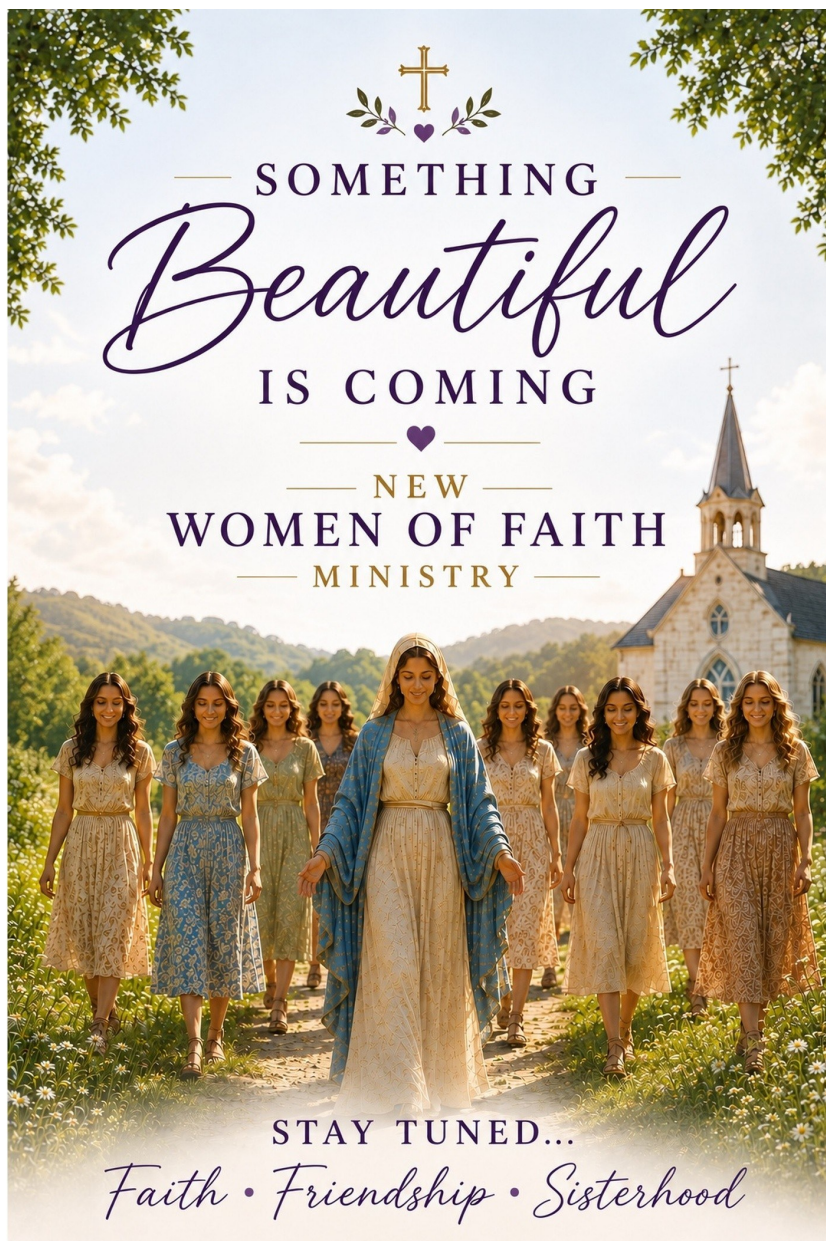

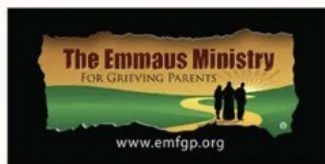

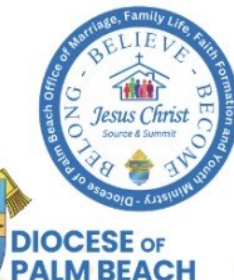
