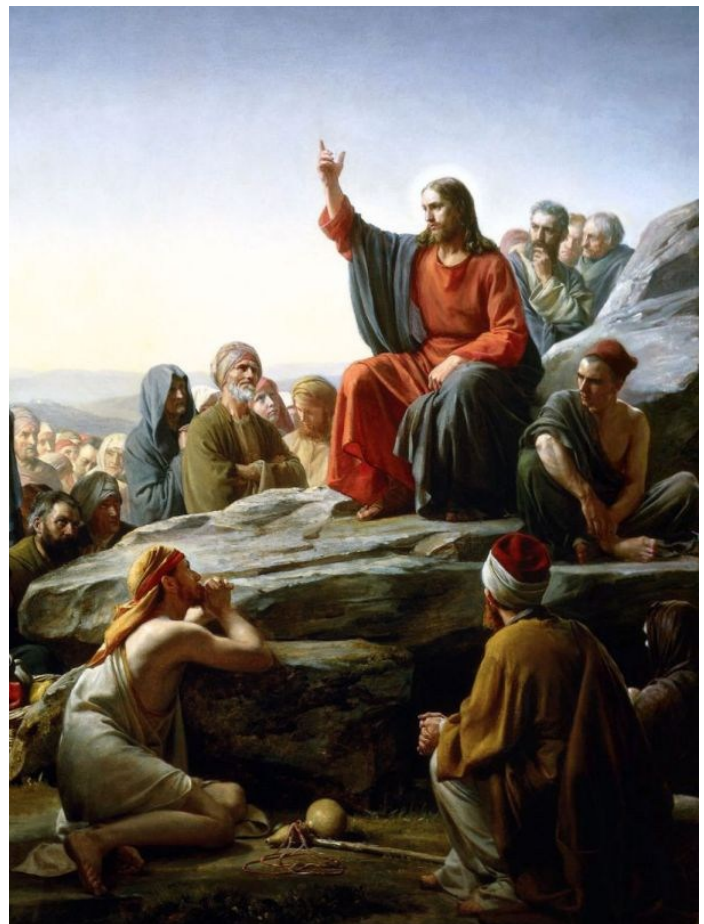

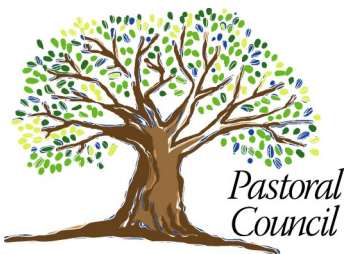

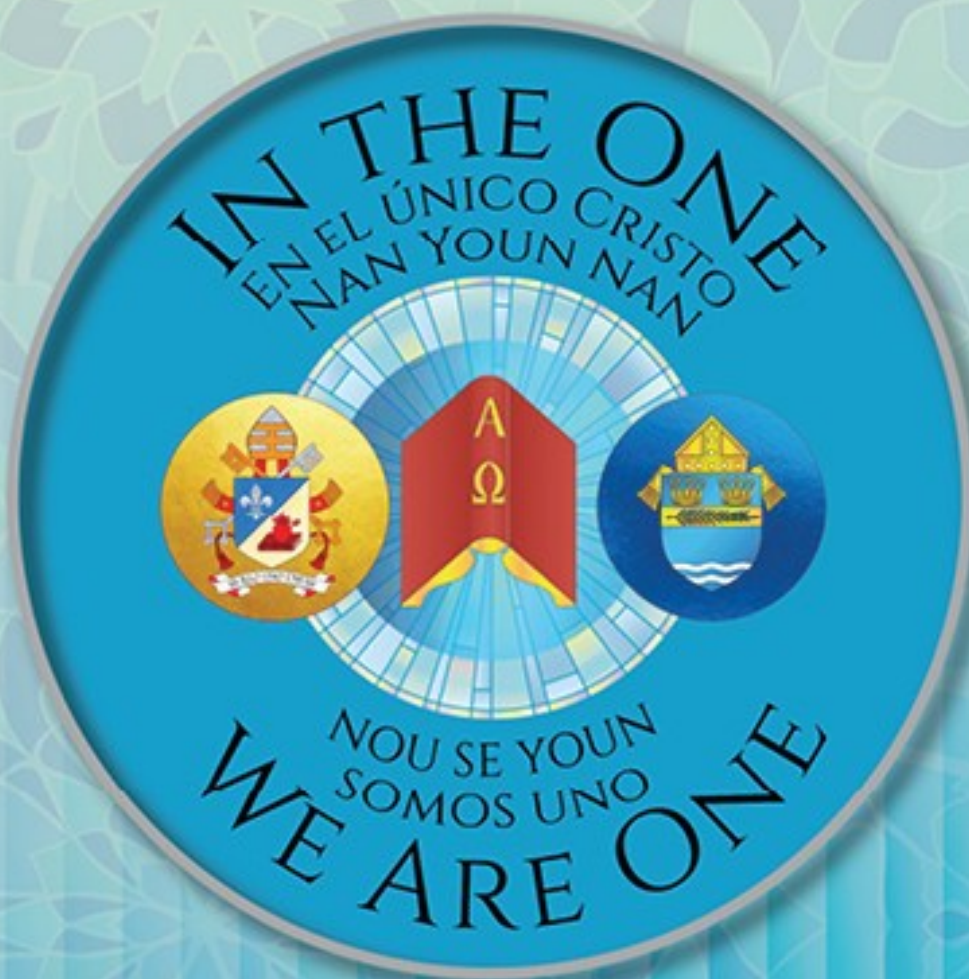
"Hospice Care: What it is, What to expect, and How we support you."

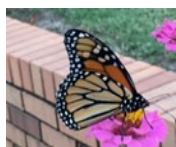
