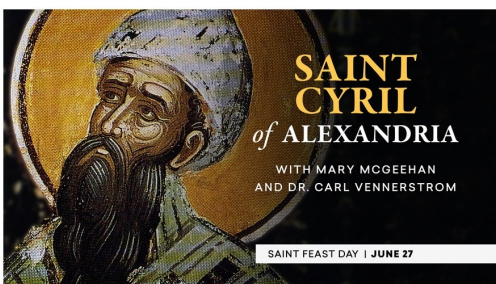
## Saint Thomas More: The Age of the Author
