

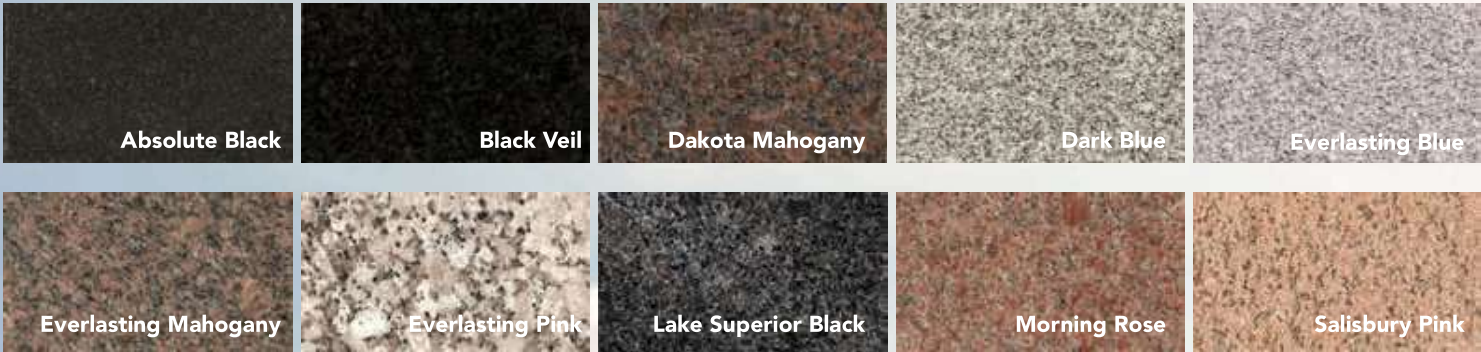
Granite Colors

Imported

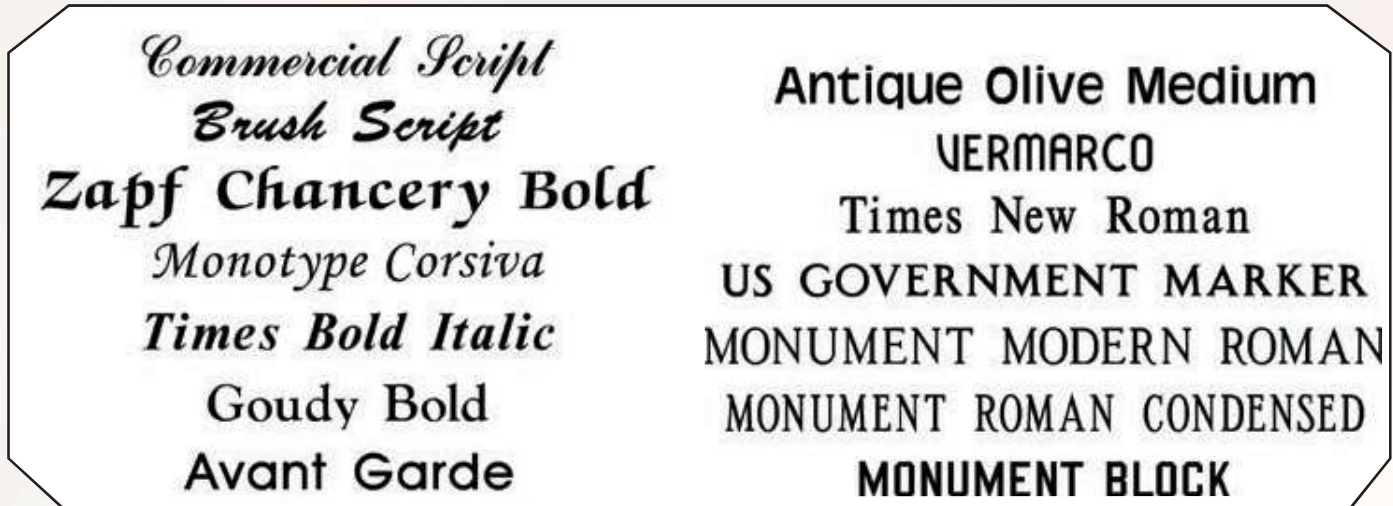

Carving Styles

Carvings on granite are by far the most widely used method of personalization on any monument. Whether it is the lack of carving expressing a minimalist personality or a highly ornate design to convey a more complex individual, the carving style you choose is just as important as the lettering. Below is a guide to help you understand the carving technique used by memorialist.

It is the process by which sand abrasive is accelerated through a blasting nozzle by means of compressed air. The sand is directed at finished stone monuments and used to create carvings and lettering on the stone. The granite industry has been using this process for many years.

Designs are cut onto rubber stencil then picked out. The rubber protects the areas of the stone that we don't want the sand to touch.
