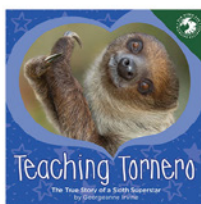

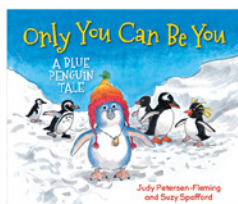

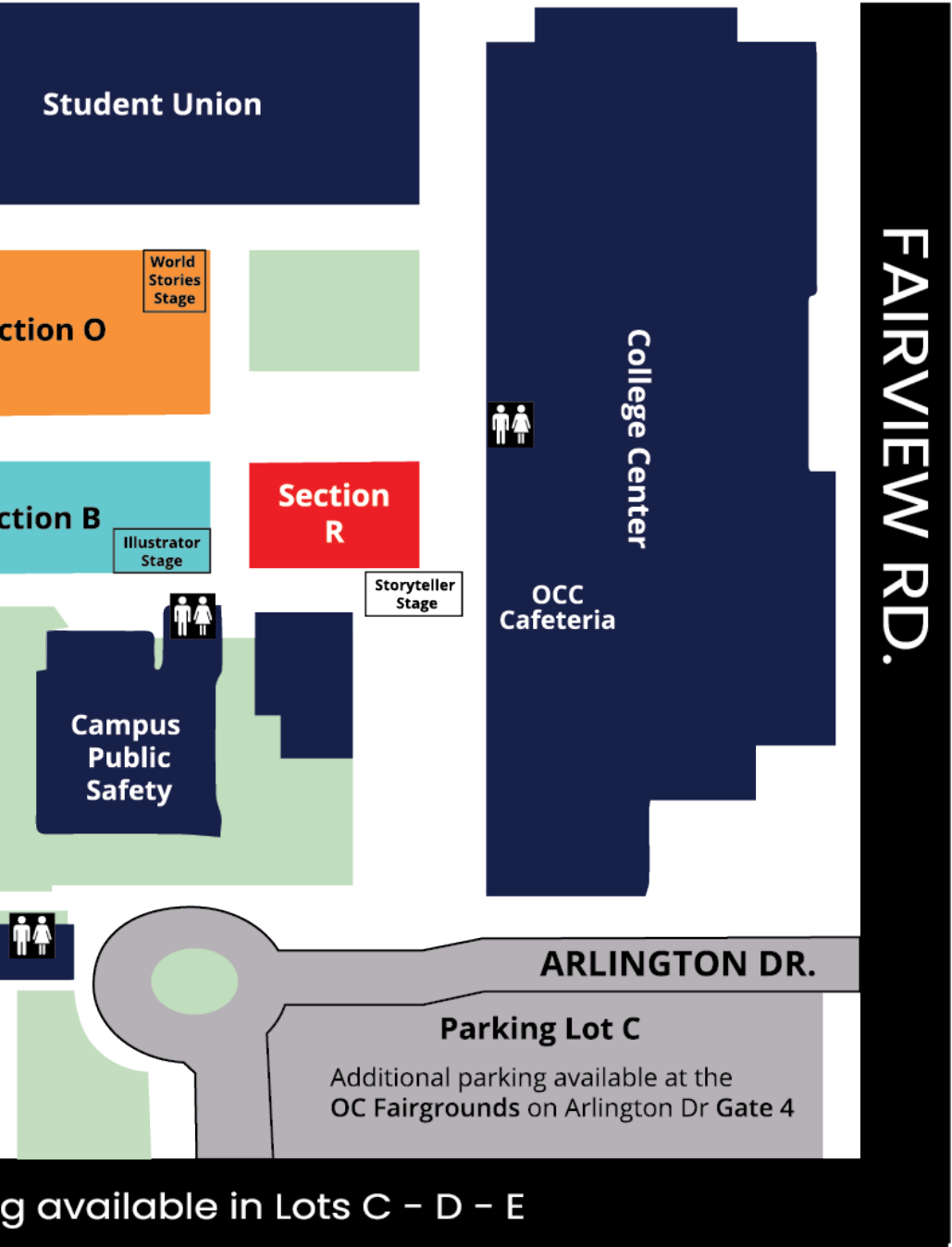

3. CATCH A PERFORMANCE

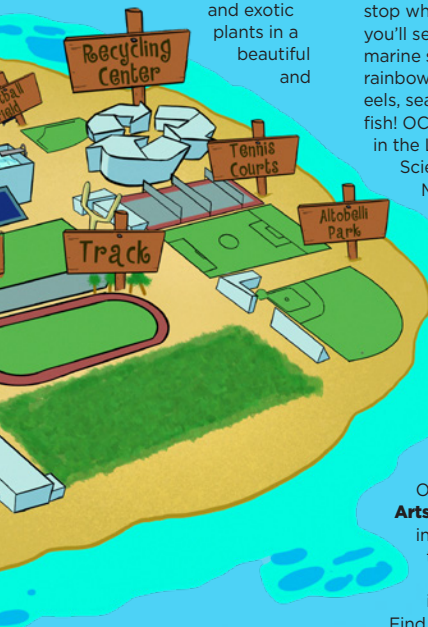
