A huge thank you to Mrs Green and Mrs Moncur for organising it, and to the parents that came to help make the gifts.

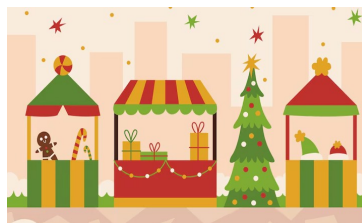


Christmas Jumper Day - 12th December
