## Catholic Life of the School

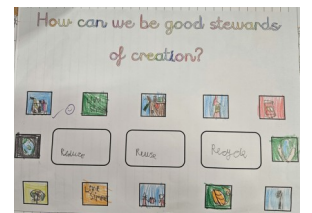
Year 5 and 6 have been praying the Rosary every day this week. Year 5 will continue next week with Mr Bevan and Mrs Pembroke.
