

2021 RUBBISH REPORT **NEW SOUTH WALES**

The 2021 Rubbish Report is a snapshot of rubbish removed by Clean Up Australia volunteers. Across NSW, the Report is based on the count of 114.067 rubbish items from 342 surveyed locations [115,256 items from 442 locations in 2020].





Despite local lockdowns and restrictions, Australians continued to Step Up to Clean Up with a 25% increase in the number of estimated volunteers across the nation.

NOTABLE CHANGES

Cigarette dominated the Top 10 Individual Items, closely followed by more familiar single use plastics Other soft plastics, plastic chip & confectionery wrappers, plastic bottle caps and lids, and plastic packaging - all %s of which were above the national average.

Also above national average % were metal bottle caps and glass pieces – demonstrating that small stuff continues to be a problem.

FAVOURITE CLEAN UP SITES

NSW volunteers reported they removed higher than average rubbish counts at beaches, in bushland, shops/malls, school grounds, at outdoor transport and dive sites.
