

# 2021 RUBBISH REPORT **SOUTH AUSTRALIA**

The 2021 Rubbish Report is a snapshot of rubbish removed by Clean Up Australia volunteers. Across SA, the Report is based on the count of 30,780 rubbish items from 67 surveyed locations [21,631 items from 86 locations in 2020].





Despite local lockdowns and restrictions, Australians continued to Step Up to Clean Up with a 25% increase in the number of estimated volunteers across the nation.

This clearly demonstrates the importance volunteers place on our local parks, streets, beaches, waterways and bushland.

SA volunteers reported above national % in soft plastics, food packaging, beverage rubbish, household items, sanitary items, construction materials and toys.

SA led Australia with highest % rankings in food packaging, beverage rubbish and household items.

NOTABLE CHANGES

Within Individual items, SA recorded higher than national % in plastic chip & confectionery wrappers, plastic food bags, plastic bottle caps & lids, foil confectionery wrappers, glass pieces and metal bottle caps reinforcing small stuff matters

SA was one of only 2 states where cigarette butts were NOT the #1 item reported. [other was TAS]

# **FAVOURITE CLEAN UP SITES**

SA volunteers reported higher than national average rubbish counts at beaches, parks, along footpaths, in bushland and school grounds.

SA volunteers were the most productive nationally at SA beaches, in bushland and school grounds.
