The 2021 Rubbish Report is a snapshot of rubbish removed by Clean Up Australia volunteers. Across VIC, the Report is based on the count of 101.525 rubbish items from 197 surveyed locations [59,159 items from 239 locations in 2020].





Despite local lockdowns and restrictions, Australians continued to Step Up to Clean Up with a 25% increase in the number of estimated volunteers across the nation.
