The 2021 Rubbish Report is a snapshot of rubbish removed by Clean Up Australia volunteers. Across WA, the Report is based on the count of 32,728 rubbish items from 88 surveyed locations [37,033 items from 105 locations in 2020].



2021 participation reflects the impact of COVID-19 on volunteer desire to join with their neighbours and friends to clean up their favourite locations.

Despite local lockdowns and restrictions, Australians continued to Step Up to Clean Up with a 25% increase in the number of estimated volunteers across the nation.

This clearly demonstrates the importance volunteers place on our local parks, streets, beaches, waterways and bushland.

NOTABLE CHANGES

Individual % counts of cigarette butts, other soft plastics, plastic bottle caps & lids, alcoholic beverage bottles, metal bottle caps, and plastic packaging were all above national % recordings

FAVOURITE CLEAN UP SITES

WA volunteers recorded the highest average counts of items from rivers/ creeks and waterways; the second highest counts from 'other' sites and the third highest average counts from roadways.
