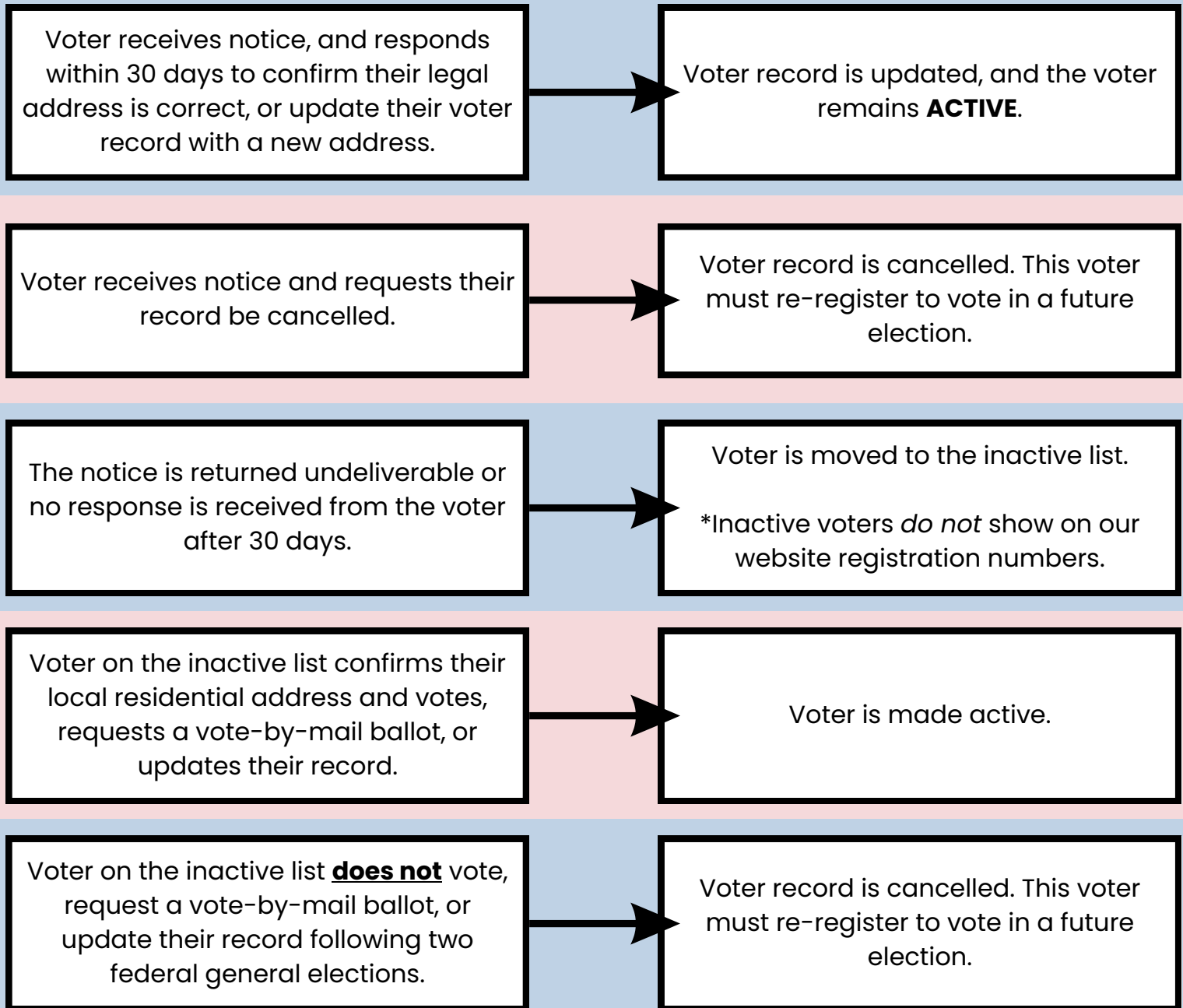


Why Did Our Registration Go Down 15,416 Voters?

In accordance with F.S. 98.065, the Supervisor of Elections Office sends a notice to all voters who have not voted during the last two general elections, 2020 and 2022, and have not contacted the Elections Office since November 2020. On August 4, 2023, these notices were mailed to 16,688 St. Johns County voters.

So what happens after a voter receives a notice?



We have now passed the 30-day mark since mailing our notices August 4, 2023. Our voter registration system has been updated according to the responses received, not received, and notices returned undeliverable, from voters who were sent notices.

The registration numbers on our website are for **ACTIVE** voters only. It does not include inactive voters.
