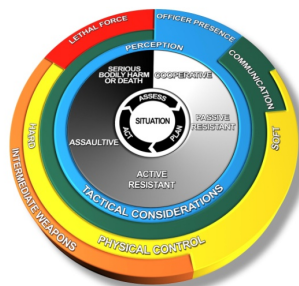
Use of Force Reports are to be Completed:

- ▶ **Handgun drawn in public or firearm pointed**
- ▶ **Other weapon is used on a subject**
- ▶ **Any physical force used on a subject that requires medical attention**
- ▶ **CEW deployed or displayed and effects the outcome of the call**

Policing Standards Manual - Use of Force – AI-012

- ▶ j) require the appointment of a training analyst responsible for:
- ▶ reviewing use of force reports to identify individual and group training requirements;
- ▶ ii) maintaining a database (electronic or manual) of use of force data from Part A of all use of force reports; and
- ▶ iii) at least once every calendar year, producing a study, including an analysis of use of force trends for the entire police service, which does not contain data that identifies reporting police officers;

Ontario Use of Force Model (2004)



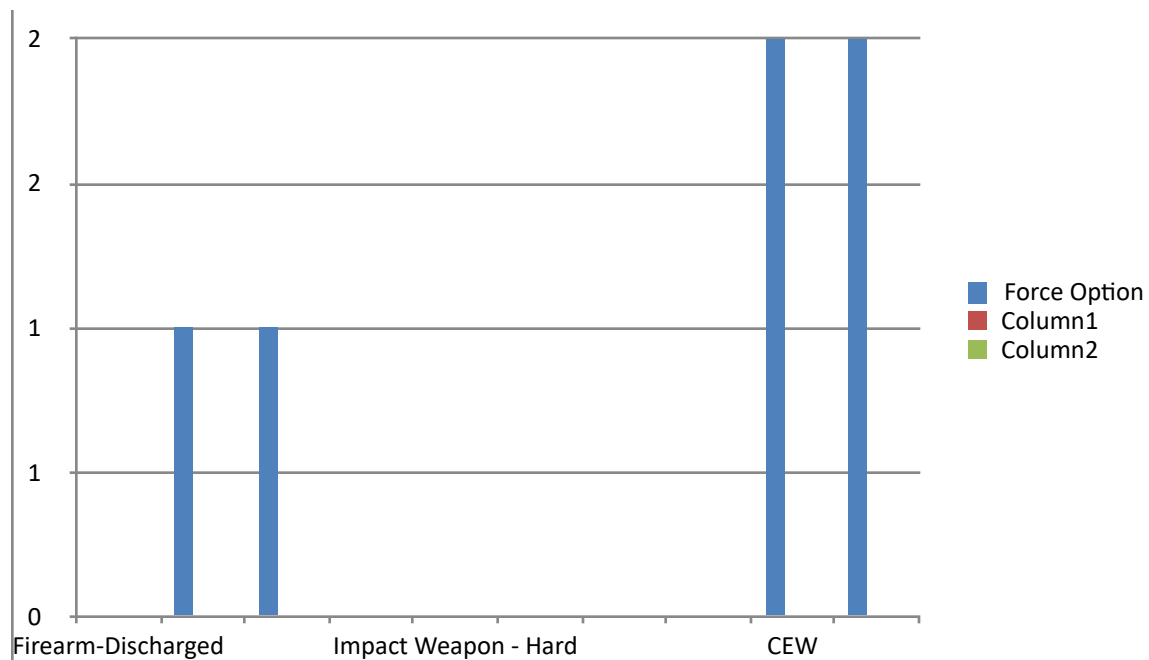
The officer continuously assesses the situation and selects the most reasonable option relative to those circumstances as perceived at that point in time.

Type of Incident (4)



- (1) Mental Health Call/Person in Crisis -Person with knife - double CEW deploymnets (2 reports)
- (1) High Risk Arrest - Containmnet of multiple suspects - carbine (C8) pointed and handgun drawn (2 reports)
- (1) High Risk Arrest - Accused person with hammer - CEW demonstrated force presence (1 report)
- (1) High Risk Arrest - Accused person with brick - CEW demonstartred force presence (1 report)
