PSB 2026-26 Court Security Prisoner Transport(CSPT) An allocation of 78,717.00 was received for this grant.

PSB 2026-27 Provincial Bail Compliance Dashboard. GPS has onboarded onto the Ontario Provincial Police (OPP) Provincial Bail Compliance Dashboard (PBCD). This project is aimed at monitoring and sharing information about individuals on bail for firearms-related offences and/or crimes against the person offences. Matt Dennison is overseeing this project.

PSB 2026-28 Statical Report. Overview provided. HTA fines and cautions have increased. Warnings are used as an educational tool.

PSB 2026-29 Backcheck revenue is up. March is the best 2nd march ever.
