### PROFESSIONAL CAREER

Averaged 6.9 points, 4.0 rebounds, 0.6 assists, and 19.8 minutes across 7 international games with Galitos Barreiro (Portugal), while shooting 51.6% from the field, 50.0% from three-point range, and 80.0% from the free-throw line.

**2025–26 (Portugal – Galitos Barreiro):** Appeared in 7 games during the 2025–26 international season, averaging 19.8 minutes, 6.9 points, 4.0 rebounds, and 0.6 assists per game while shooting an efficient 51.6% from the field, 50.0% from three-point range, and 80.0% from the free-throw line... Split time between a starting and bench role, providing versatility at the forward position... Opened the stretch with 3 points in a win over Imortal Albufeira (Nov. 15)... Delivered a strong performance with 18 points and 7 rebounds against Vitoria Alves Guimaraes (Dec. 6)... Added 12 points on efficient shooting versus FC Porto Ferpinta (Dec. 27)... Recorded 9 points and 5 rebounds against ADO Basquetebol Sad Ovarense (Jan. 3)... Contributed 4 points and 5 rebounds versus SL Benfica (Jan. 14)... Provided efficient scoring, rebounding presence, and floor spacing throughout the stint, highlighted by strong shooting efficiency and the ability to contribute in both starting and reserve roles.

### UNIVERSITY CAREER

Averaged 10.3 points, 6.1 rebounds, 1.5 assists, and 25.0 minutes across 94 collegiate games with McGill University (U SPORTS), NCAA Division II programs, and the University of Vermont (NCAA Division I), while establishing himself as a reliable frontcourt contributor with consistent rebounding presence and efficient interior scoring.

Opened the season with 10 points and 10 rebounds against Air Force (Aug. 3)... Posted 15 points and 10 rebounds versus UAlbany (Aug. 5)... Recorded 14 points and 11 rebounds against Catholic University (Aug. 21)... Delivered 16 points against Moravian (Oct. 5)... Added 19 points versus Guelph (Oct.

11)... Registered 14 points against Toronto (Oct. 12)... Posted 16 points against UPEI (Oct. 17)... Delivered 19 points versus Macalester College (Oct. 18)... Delivered 15 points on efficient shooting versus Hawaii Pacific (Nov. 15)... Recorded 10 points against Vancouver Island (Nov. 18)... Added 11 points versus MSU Denver (Nov. 25)... Posted 11 points against Douglas (Nov. 19)... Recorded 16 points and 11 rebounds versus St. Edward's (Dec. 18)... Delivered 17 points on efficient shooting against Chaminade (Dec. 19)... Broke out with a season-high 20 points against Saint Martin's (Dec. 29)... Added 10 points versus Seattle Pacific (Jan. 5)... Contributed 7 points against Alaska Anchorage (Jan. 14)... Recorded 9 points on efficient shooting versus Alaska Anchorage (Feb. 9)... Closed the season with 8 points against Western Washington (Feb. 25)... Showed consistent scoring ability early in the season with strong rebounding presence, while maintaining efficiency as a frontcourt contributor.

Scored 4 points on perfect shooting against Maine (Mar. 1)... Added 3 points versus NJIT (Mar. 6)... Recorded 2 points and 2 rebounds against Binghamton (Feb. 9)... Contributed 2 points versus UMBC (Feb. 19)... Added 2 points against Worcester Polytechnic (Nov. 16)... Provided energy in limited minutes, contributing efficiently in short appearances off the bench.

**2020–21 (Vermont):** Appeared in 5 games during the 2020–21 season, averaging 2.6 minutes, 0.8 points, and 0.6 rebounds per game while playing a limited reserve role... Scored 2 points on perfect shooting against Binghamton (Jan. 10)... Added 2 points and 1 rebound versus NJIT (Dec. 27)... Saw limited action throughout the season, contributing in short bench minutes.

Georges Lefebvre is a 6-foot-9 forward from Montreal, Quebec, the son of Aymerie Lefebvre and Nadine Ngongo, and has a younger sibling, Yena. His name is pronounced "GEORGE LA-FAVE." Prior to his university career, he attended Cape Fear Academy in Wilmington, North Carolina, where he was an honour roll student and earned NCISAA All-Conference honours in both his junior and senior years, as well as NCISAA All-State recognition in his final season, highlighting a strong academic and athletic background.
