### PROFESSIONAL CAREER

Averaged approximately 11.0 points, 5.9 rebounds, 2.3 assists, 1.3 steals, and 0.8 blocks in 27.5 minutes across multiple professional seasons in France and Canada (CEBL), shooting roughly 43–45% from the field and about 31–34% from three-point range... Compiled these numbers over stints with GET Vosges, FC Mulhouse Basket, Denain ASC Voltaire, Saint-Chamond Basket, CEP Lorient, and the Niagara River Lions... Established himself as a versatile wing/forward who consistently contributed across the box score, highlighted by multiple high-output performances including 30+ point games, several 20+ point outings, and numerous double-digit rebounding efforts across different seasons... Delivered strong all-around stat lines such as 14.8 points, 7.2 rebounds, 2.9 assists (2018–19), 14.2 points, 7.9 rebounds, 3.1 assists (2019–20), and 12.9 points, 6.6 rebounds, 3.2 assists (2020–21), showing steady production in various roles... Demonstrated consistent two-way impact with defensive activity, rebounding presence, and secondary playmaking, while maintaining adaptability as both a starter and rotation contributor across international competition.

**2024–25 (France / Canada – CEP Lorient & Niagara River Lions):** Appeared across international competition with CEP Lorient (France) and the Niagara River Lions (CEBL) during the 2024–25 season, averaging 8.8 points, 4.6 rebounds, and 1.5 assists in 20.4 minutes per game, while shooting 44.9% from the field... Began the season in France, where he demonstrated strong scoring efficiency and versatility on the wing, including a 23-point performance on 7-of-12 shooting with 2 three-pointers against SO Maritime Boulogne (Apr. 11)... Added 17 points and 6 rebounds vs. Besançon (Apr. 18) and recorded multiple double-digit scoring outings, including 15 points vs. Union Sportive Avignon (Mar. 28) and 13 points vs. Metz (Apr. 2)... Transitioned to the Niagara River Lions, where he took on a frontcourt role and contributed as both a starter and key rotation piece... Delivered a 15-point, 10-rebound double-double against Vancouver (May 22) and followed with 15 points and 9 rebounds vs. Calgary (May 16)... Added 11 points and 8 rebounds against Ottawa (May 18) and showcased efficiency with 15 points on 5-of-6 shooting vs. Brampton (July 16)... Pulled down a season-high 11 rebounds vs. Scarborough (July 20) and recorded a 5-assist outing against Montreal (July 25)... Demonstrated a consistent interior presence, rebounding ability, and positional versatility, contributing on both ends of the floor throughout the season.

**2023–24 (France / Canada – STB Le Havre, Denain ASC Voltaire & Montreal Alliance):** Appeared across multiple stops in France and the CEBL during the 2023–24 season, averaging 7.2 points, 4.5 rebounds, and 1.5 assists in 22.5 minutes per game, while shooting 39.4% from the field... Opened the season with STB Le Havre, recording 13 points on 5-of-9 shooting vs. Feurs (Oct. 13) and contributing a well-rounded 11-point, 7-rebound, 6-assist, 4-steal performance vs. Mulhouse (Oct. 27)... Transitioned to Denain ASC Voltaire, where he showcased versatility across multiple positions, highlighted by a 24-point, 9-rebound outing vs. Rouen (Jan. 26) and a 16-point performance on 5-of-7 shooting vs. Fos-sur-Mer (Jan. 12)... Added consistent contributions with 10 points and 8 rebounds vs. Lille (Mar. 26) and 9 points and 5 rebounds vs. Orléans (Mar. 8)... Closed the season with the Montreal Alliance, stepping into a starting role and delivering impactful performances, including a 21-point outing on 7-of-13 shooting vs. Saskatchewan (July 26)... Added 15 points on 6-of-9 shooting vs. Winnipeg (July 5) and recorded strong all-around games with 12 points, 8 rebounds, and 6 steals vs. Brampton (June 28)... Demonstrated positional flexibility between the wing and forward spots, along with defensive activity and rebounding presence, contributing consistently across multiple statistical categories.

**2022–23 (France – Saint Chamond Basket):** Appeared in international competition with Saint Chamond Basket during the 2022–23 season, averaging 7.3 points, 3.4 rebounds, and 1.8 assists in 22.2 minutes per game, while shooting 40.2% from the field and 33.3% from three-point range... Opened the season with a strong performance, recording 19 points on 5-of-7 shooting, including 2-of-3 from beyond the arc, along with 7-of-9 from the free-throw line vs. Boulazac (Sept. 30)... Followed with 15 points vs. Lille (Oct. 21) and added 11 points on 4-of-7 shooting in a win over Orléans (Nov. 26)... Delivered an efficient outing with 15 points and 4 three-pointers on 5-of-9 shooting vs. Denain (Jan. 10)... Contributed across multiple categories with a 10-point, 6-rebound performance vs. Saint-Quentin (Nov. 29) and a 6-point, 10-rebound, 4-assist game vs. Boulazac (Dec. 2)... Demonstrated perimeter shooting ability, positional versatility between the wing spots, and the ability to contribute as both a starter and rotation player throughout the season.

**2021–22 (France – Denain ASC Voltaire):** Appeared in international competition with Denain ASC Voltaire during the 2021–22 season, averaging 9.4 points, 6.7 rebounds, and 2.0 assists in 28.6 minutes per game, while shooting 38.4% from the field and 34.0% from three-point range... Delivered a breakout performance with 22 points on 7-of-11 shooting, including 4-of-5 from three-point range, along with 10 rebounds vs. Nancy (Nov. 12)... Recorded a strong all-around showing with 14 points, 13 rebounds, and 7 assists vs. Quimper (Dec. 27)... Added 16 points and 12 rebounds vs. Saint-Quentin (Dec. 17) and followed with another 16-point, 12-rebound performance vs. Aix Maurienne (Feb. 1)... Contributed 15 points and 10 rebounds vs. Antibes (Feb. 18) and 15 points on 6-of-11 shooting vs. Boulazac (Mar. 5)... Showcased perimeter shooting ability with multiple multi-three-point games, including 4-of-8 from beyond the arc vs. Aix Maurienne (Feb. 1) and 3-of-3 shooting from three vs. Évreux (Jan. 28)... Demonstrated strong rebounding presence, defensive activity, and versatility on the wing, consistently contributing across multiple statistical categories as a full-time starter.

**2020–21 (France / Canada – FC Mulhouse Basket & Niagara River Lions):** Appeared across international competition with FC Mulhouse Basket (France) and the Niagara River Lions (CEBL) during the 2020–21 season, averaging 12.9 points, 6.6 rebounds, and 3.2 assists in 32.8 minutes per

game, while shooting 45.6% from the field... Delivered multiple standout performances in France, including a 28-point outing on 11-of-19 shooting vs. GET Vosges (Jan. 19) and a dominant 28-point, 12-rebound performance with 6 assists vs. Besançon (Jan. 8)... Added 23 points on 9-of-15 shooting vs. BC Orchies (Oct. 20) and 21 points on 8-of-11 shooting vs. Besançon (Apr. 6)... Contributed across the board with a 20-point, 5-rebound, 4-assist performance vs. Andrézieux (Mar. 30) and 17 points and 10 rebounds vs. GET Vosges (Mar. 27)... Transitioned to the Niagara River Lions, where he maintained a starting role at the forward position, highlighted by a 16-point performance vs. Ottawa (Aug. 8) and a 12-point, 10-rebound, 5-assist outing vs. Vancouver (July 8)... Added a strong all-around showing with 9 points, 12 rebounds, and 6 assists vs. Saskatchewan (July 20)... **2019–20 (France / Canada – FC Mulhouse Basket & Niagara River Lions):** Appeared across international competition with FC Mulhouse Basket (France) and the Niagara River Lions (CEBL) during the 2019–20 season, averaging 14.2 points, 7.9 rebounds, and 3.1 assists in 34.3 minutes per game, while shooting 41.0% from the field... Delivered a breakout campaign in France with multiple high-level performances, including a 32-point, 15-rebound outing vs. Andrézieux (Sept. 20) and a 27-point performance vs. Besançon (Nov. 8)... Added 22 points on 10-of-17 shooting vs. Chartres (Jan. 24) and 21 points, 14 rebounds, and 6 assists vs. La Charité (Nov. 29)... Contributed consistently across the board with 21 points vs. GET Vosges (Dec. 13) and 20 points vs. Andrézieux (Mar. 30)... Showcased strong rebounding presence with multiple double-digit rebounding performances, including 14 rebounds vs. La Charité (Feb. 29) and 12 rebounds vs. Besançon (Jan. 8)... Transitioned to the Niagara River Lions, where he started all appearances and contributed as a frontcourt presence, highlighted by a 12-point performance on 4-of-6 shooting vs. Brampton (July 25) and an 8-point, 8-rebound outing vs. Vancouver (Aug. 2)... Demonstrated versatility as a forward with scoring ability, rebounding strength, and playmaking instincts, consistently impacting the game across multiple statistical categories.

**2018–19 (Canada / Czech Republic – Island Storm, St. John's Edge & SLUNETÁ Ústí nad Labem):** Appeared across international competition during the 2018–19 season, splitting time between the Island Storm (NBL Canada), St. John's Edge, and SLUNETÁ Ústí nad Labem, averaging 14.8 points, 7.2 rebounds, and 2.9 assists in 30.1 minutes per game, while shooting 45.4% from the field, 30.9% from three-point range, and 77.8% from the free-throw line... Delivered a dominant offensive season highlighted by multiple high-volume scoring performances, including a 39-point outing vs. Cape Breton (Mar. 1), a 33-point performance vs. Cape Breton (Mar. 30), and a 32-point, 15-rebound game vs. Moncton (Feb. 24)... Added a 30-point performance vs. St. John's Edge (Mar. 23) and a 29-point, 13-rebound effort vs. Halifax (Feb. 21), showcasing consistent ability to produce at a high level against top competition... Recorded several double-digit rebounding performances throughout the season, including multiple games with 10+ rebounds, while also contributing as a playmaker with multiple multi-assist outings, including an 8-assist performance vs. Halifax (Mar. 3) and strong all-around production in key wins... **2017–18 (Canada – Niagara River Lions):** Appeared in the 2017–18 season with the Niagara River Lions in the Canadian Elite Basketball League/NBL Canada, establishing himself as a primary two-way contributor and consistent starter, averaging 14.2 points, 7.7 rebounds, and 3.0 assists in 33.3 minutes per game, while shooting 45.3% from the field, 31.7% from three-point range, and 80.3% from the free-throw line... Delivered a breakout scoring season highlighted by multiple high-level performances, including a 34-point, 12-rebound, 4-assist game vs. St. John's (Jan. 19) and a 31-point performance vs. St. John's (Jan. 21)... Added a 25-point outing vs. London (Jan. 7) and another 25-point performance vs. London (Apr. 10), showing consistent production against top competition... Recorded several strong all-around games, including a 20-point, 12-rebound, 4-block performance vs. London (Apr. 13) and a 19-point, 13-rebound game vs. KW Titans (Mar. 9), demonstrating strong defensive impact and rebounding presence... Contributed across multiple statistical categories throughout the season, regularly producing double-digit scoring with strong rebounding totals and defensive activity, while emerging as a reliable starter capable of handling high-minute workloads and producing in both scoring and physical frontcourt roles.

**2016–17 (France – GET Vosges):** Appeared in the 2016–17 international season with GET Vosges in France, contributing as a versatile wing and combo forward while splitting time between bench and starting roles, averaging 9.8 points, 4.5 rebounds, and 1.5 assists in 23.4 minutes per game, while shooting 44.3% from the field and 31.5% from three-point range... Showcased scoring potential and efficiency in key performances throughout the season, highlighted by a 28-point, 11-rebound outing vs. Chartres (Nov. 25) and a 23-point performance vs. Vitre (Feb. 25)... Added a 21-point game vs. Orchies (Jan. 6) and a 17-point, 9-rebound performance vs. Tarbes (Feb. 3), demonstrating ability to impact both scoring and rebounding... Provided strong all-around contributions in multiple roles, including efficient shooting nights such as 16 points on 6-of-11 shooting vs. Rennes (Apr. 15) and a 15-point performance vs. Rueil (Oct. 22)... Showed defensive versatility and energy on the wing, contributing steals, rebounds, and secondary playmaking while adjusting between starter and bench responsibilities... Established himself as a developing two-way contributor capable of scoring in bursts, rebounding from the perimeter, and providing depth across multiple lineup roles in a competitive European league environment.

Delivered multiple standout performances, including 23 points at Laurentian (Feb. 26) on 7-of-8 shooting, 20 points vs. Ottawa (Jan. 16), 19-point outings against Windsor (Nov. 28) and York (Jan. 29), and 18 points vs. Acadia (Oct. 16) and Brock (Feb. 12)... Showcased strong shooting efficiency in conference play, highlighted by high-percentage scoring stretches against McMaster (Feb. 13) and Laurier (Feb. 19)... Played a consistent starting role in high-leverage games, contributing as a reliable scorer and defensive presence for one of Canada's top university programs.

**2014–15:** Played a consistent rotational role for Carleton during a dominant national season, contributing as an efficient scoring wing within a deep championship-caliber roster... Appeared in

every phase of the season with increased minutes and offensive responsibility off the bench... Recorded double-digit scoring performances against Brock (Nov. 7, 10 pts), McMaster (Nov. 8, 10 pts on 5-of-6 shooting), Waterloo (Nov. 22, 13 pts on 6-of-7 shooting), Toronto (Nov. 28, 12 pts), Guelph (Jan. 16, 13 pts), and Nipissing (Feb. 21, 14 pts on 7-of-13 shooting)... Added a season-high 17 points at Queen's (Feb. 13), showcasing efficient finishing and perimeter scoring... Maintained strong shooting efficiency throughout the year, particularly in high-percentage interior scoring opportunities, while contributing steady rebounding and defensive effort within Carleton's structured system.

**2013–14:** Contributed in a depth role for Carleton during another dominant national season... Appeared in limited minutes across a stacked roster, providing energy and support on both ends while continuing development within a high-performance system... Recorded his most productive outings against Western (Nov. 2) with 8 points, Lakehead (Nov. 8) with 5 points including a three-pointer, and Toronto (Jan. 18) with 10 points on 3-of-6 shooting... Added efficient scoring in spurts, including perfect shooting performances against Dalhousie (Oct. 4) and Brock (Nov. 16)... Served as a reliable rotation piece in select games, gaining experience within one of Canada's top university programs and contributing to a consistently winning environment.

**2012–13:** Appeared in a limited bench role for Carleton during a dominant national season... Saw sparse minutes in select games, including Western (Nov. 10) and Waterloo (Nov. 30), where he scored 2 points on perfect free throw shooting... Contributed within a deep, championship-level roster while gaining experience in a high-performance defensive system and continuing his development within one of Canada's top university programs.

**2011–12:** Appeared in 22 regular-season games as a freshman, providing a depth and developmental role off the bench for Windsor... Logged limited minutes in a defensive-oriented role while adjusting to the university level, with most contributions coming in short bursts of energy, rebounding, and team defense... Recorded his strongest offensive outings against Queen's (Jan. 20) with 6 points on 2-of-3 shooting, RMC (Jan. 21) with 8 points and 4-of-4 from the free-throw line, and York (Jan. 27) with 8 points on 3-of-4 shooting... Added a steady 3-point performance at Guelph (Nov. 25) and chipped in 2-point efforts against Brock (Nov. 12) and Western (Nov. 18)... Demonstrated efficiency when given opportunities, highlighted by a perfect shooting game at Guelph (Nov. 25, 1-of-1 FG) and strong free-throw reliability in limited attempts... Contributed across a dominant Windsor team season, gaining early collegiate experience, defensive reps, and foundational development that set the stage for an expanded role in subsequent years.

## **PERSONAL**

Guillaume Boucard is a Canadian forward known for his consistency, toughness, and high motor on both ends of the floor. A former standout at Carleton University, he won five consecutive national championships and developed into a reliable, high-IQ player with a strong defensive presence and ability to impact the game in transition.

At the professional level, he has earned multiple league honors, including CEBL Canadian Player of the Year and All-Star First Team recognition in 2019, establishing himself as a dependable and respected veteran in Canadian basketball.
