PROFESSIONAL CAREER

Averaged 17.8 points, 5.5 rebounds, and 3.1 assists in 30.3 minutes per game across his professional career, spanning the NBA, NBA G League, and international competition, while shooting approximately 44.0% from the field and 34.0% from three-point range... Established himself as a dynamic scoring guard/wing capable of producing at multiple levels, consistently contributing as a primary or secondary offensive option depending on role and context... Demonstrated strong versatility throughout his career, impacting games as a scorer, playmaker, rebounder, and perimeter defender across varied leagues and competition levels while adapting seamlessly between starting and bench responsibilities.

2025–26 (International): Appeared in 11 games, including 8 starts, averaging 14.0 points, 4.8 rebounds, 3.5 assists, and 1.9 steals in 28.5 minutes per game while shooting 39.7% from the field, 25.0% from three-point range, and 79.5% from the free-throw line... Opened the stretch with a 27-point performance in a win over Sydney (Aug 28, 2025), followed by strong all-around outings including 21 points against Cairns (Sept 26, 2025) and 17 points with 6 rebounds versus New Zealand (Sept 19, 2025)... Maintained consistent two-way production through the season, highlighted by a 21-point effort against Melbourne (Dec 27, 2025) and an 11-rebound performance versus New Zealand (Dec 22, 2025)... Finished the run with a steady offensive role while contributing as a scorer, playmaker, and perimeter defender across both starting and bench roles throughout the campaign.

2025–26 (NBA G League – Long Island Nets): Appeared in 6 games with the Long Island Nets, averaging 13.1 points, 3.9 rebounds, and 3.0 assists in 30.1 minutes per game while shooting 40.2% from the field, 26.8% from three-point range, and 75.0% from the free-throw line (Mar 17, 2026; Mar 19, 2026; Mar 22, 2026; Mar 24, 2026; Mar 25, 2026; Mar 28, 2026; Apr 1, 2026)... Contributed as a scoring wing and secondary playmaker in both starting and bench roles, showing the ability to create offense in multiple lineups while maintaining steady rebounding and defensive activity throughout the stretch.

2024–25 (International) : Appeared in 2 games, both starts, averaging 15.5 points, 5.5 rebounds, and 2.5 assists in 35.1 minutes per game while shooting 46.4% from the field, 25.0% from three-point range, and 100% from the free-throw line... Opened the season with a 22-point performance in a win over UCAM Murcia CB (Oct 1, 2024), showing efficient scoring and strong all-around play... Followed with a 9-point, 5-rebound outing against Bursaspor (Oct 5, 2024), contributing defensively and on the glass in a tougher shooting night... Demonstrated consistent two-way impact across both appearances, providing scoring, rebounding, and defensive activity as a reliable starter throughout the stretch.

2024–25 (NBA G League – Westchester Knicks): Appeared in 19 games, including 15 starts, averaging 20.1 points, 6.7 rebounds, and 3.4 assists in 34.7 minutes per game while shooting 43.2% from the field, 32.6% from three-point range, and 66.2% from the free-throw line... Served as a primary offensive option throughout the season, consistently generating scoring production as a high-usage guard/wing while also contributing as a secondary playmaker and rebounder across both starting and bench roles... Delivered multiple standout performances, including a 32-point outing (Nov 10, 2024) vs Gold, a 26-point game (Nov 17, 2024) vs Cruise, and a 29-point performance (Mar 17, 2025) vs 905, showing his ability to create offense at a high level against strong competition... Provided strong all-around impact on the glass and defensively, highlighted by a 13-rebound performance (Mar 15, 2025) and several games with multiple assists and steals... Maintained consistent scoring pressure across the season while adapting to different lineup roles and usage levels, finishing as one of the team's most reliable two-way contributors.

2023–24 (NBA – Toronto Raptors): Appeared in 22 NBA regular season games with the Toronto Raptors, earning six starts while averaging 7.0 points, 3.2 rebounds, and 1.8 assists in 18.3 minutes per game, shooting 44.4% from the field, 23.8% from three-point range, and 91.7% from the free-throw line... Established himself as an efficient frontcourt contributor, providing energy, rebounding, and secondary playmaking in both starting and rotation roles... Elevated his production significantly as a starter, averaging 13.0 points, 4.8 rebounds, and 3.0 assists in 30.7 minutes per game while shooting 51.7% from the field... Finished the season strongly, averaging 9.4 points and 4.2 rebounds over his final 10 games and 8.8 points over his last five contests... Recorded solid performances against top competition, averaging 7.8 points per game versus opponents with top-10 records while maintaining efficient scoring and strong rebounding activity... Demonstrated versatility across multiple frontcourt matchups, contributing as a rebounder, interior finisher, and high-energy rotation player throughout the season.

2023–24 (NBA G League – Raptors 905): Appeared in 26 games, including 24 starts, averaging 24.0 points, 6.8 rebounds, and 4.0 assists in 34.7 minutes per game while shooting 46.7% from the field, 35.8% from three-point range, and 82.5% from the free-throw line... Established himself as a primary offensive engine throughout the season, consistently generating high-volume scoring while also contributing as a secondary playmaker and rebounder across multiple guard and wing roles... Delivered numerous standout performances, including a 40-point game (Jan 9, 2024) vs Legends, a 37-point outing (Jan 24, 2024) vs Gold, and a 36-point performance (Feb 24, 2024) vs Warriors, highlighting his ability to take over games offensively against top competition... Added strong all-around production with multiple games of 5+ assists and strong rebounding efforts, including a

14-rebound performance (Feb 23, 2024), while also providing defensive activity with steals and secondary rim protection... Maintained consistent high-level scoring and efficiency throughout the season, finishing as one of the team's most reliable and dynamic two-way contributors.

2022–23 (NBA G League – Westchester Knicks): Appeared in 35 games, including 12 starts, averaging 14.8 points, 4.9 rebounds, and 2.3 assists in 25.3 minutes per game while shooting 50.4% from the field, 36.4% from three-point range, and 73.9% from the free-throw line... Began the season primarily in a bench role before expanding into a larger offensive role with occasional starts, providing consistent scoring efficiency and strong two-way impact throughout the year... Delivered several high-level performances, including a 39-point outing (Jan 16, 2023) vs Charge, a 37-point game (Jan 21, 2023) vs Swarm, and a 31-point performance (Jan 19, 2023) vs Skyhawks, showing his ability to take over offensively when given increased usage... Contributed across multiple statistical categories with steady rebounding, perimeter shooting, and defensive activity, including multiple games with 5+ rebounds and 2+ assists... Showcased strong efficiency in both catch-and-shoot and driving situations while adapting to varying minutes and lineup roles over the course of the season.

UNIVERSITY CAREER

Averaged 16.5 points, 5.7 rebounds, and 2.8 assists in 32.9 minutes per game across his NCAA career (Valparaiso and DePaul), while shooting approximately 43.6% from the field, 31.0% from three-point range, and 73.5% from the free-throw line... Developed into a high-usage perimeter creator who progressively expanded his offensive role each season, evolving from a reliable starter into a primary scoring option capable of carrying significant offensive responsibility in high-level conference play... Produced numerous standout scoring performances, including multiple 30+ and 35+ point games, highlighted by explosive outings against top competition such as St. John's, Villanova, and Cincinnati... Consistently contributed across multiple categories beyond scoring, adding rebounding, secondary playmaking, and defensive activity from the guard and wing positions... Demonstrated strong versatility throughout his college career, operating both on and off the ball while maintaining steady production and improving efficiency against increasingly stronger competition year over year.

2021–22 (NCAA – DePaul): Appeared in 23 games, all starts, averaging 21.7 points, 7.2 rebounds, and 3.2 assists in 35.0 minutes per game while shooting 43.0% from the field, 36.8% from three-point range, and 73.9% from the free-throw line... Had several standout performances, including a 33-point game (Nov 20, 2021) vs Western Illinois and a 34-point performance (Jan 8, 2022) vs Villanova, along with a 26-point outing (Mar 2, 2022) vs Marquette and a 39-point game (Feb 27, 2022) vs St. John's, showing his ability to score at a high level across different stages of the season... Emerged as a primary offensive focal point, consistently producing high-volume scoring while also contributing as a rebounder and secondary playmaker from the guard position... Demonstrated strong versatility across both guard roles, functioning as a lead initiator at times while also playing off the ball to create scoring opportunities... Maintained steady all-around production throughout the season, combining efficient perimeter shooting with strong interior finishing and consistent rebounding for a perimeter player.

2020–21 (NCAA – DePaul): Appeared in 13 games, all starts, averaging 14.4 points, 5.3 rebounds, and 2.6 assists in 31.9 minutes per game while shooting 42.7% from the field, 29.3% from three-point

range, and 74.0% from the free-throw line... Took on a featured offensive role for stretches, serving as a primary scoring option while also contributing as a secondary playmaker and rebounder in the backcourt and wing positions... Delivered several strong performances, including a 26-point game (Feb 6, 2021) vs Butler, a 22-point outing (Jan 9, 2021) vs Seton Hall, and a 21-point performance (Mar 10, 2021) vs Providence, showing his ability to score efficiently against high-level conference competition... Maintained consistent production throughout the season despite a limited schedule, providing steady offensive output and physical rebounding from the guard spot... Demonstrated versatility in multiple roles within the lineup, adapting between shooting guard and small forward responsibilities while remaining a reliable two-way contributor.

2019–20 (NCAA – Valparaiso): Appeared in 30 games, all starts, averaging 19.0 points, 6.1 rebounds, and 3.2 assists in 33.3 minutes per game while shooting 43.6% from the field, 28.7% from three-point range, and 75.0% from the free-throw line... Served as a primary offensive option and lead guard, consistently generating high-volume scoring while also contributing as a secondary playmaker and rebounder across all areas of the floor... Delivered multiple standout performances, including a 32-point outing (Nov 25, 2019) vs Cincinnati, a 30-point game (Nov 12, 2019) vs SIU-Edwardsville, and a 28-point performance (Jan 15, 2020) vs Northern Iowa, showing his ability to score against strong competition throughout the season... Maintained steady production as a focal point of the offense, producing efficient scoring stretches in wins while also handling significant defensive responsibilities and heavy minutes... Demonstrated consistency as a high-usage perimeter creator, impacting games through scoring, rebounding, and playmaking in a full-time starting role.

2018–19 (NCAA – Valparaiso): Appeared in 31 games, all starts, averaging 11.0 points, 4.3 rebounds, and 2.0 assists in 31.3 minutes per game while shooting 45.2% from the field, 28.9% from three-point range, and 69.3% from the free-throw line... Played a consistent two-way role as a starter, contributing as a scorer, rebounder, and secondary playmaker while adapting between guard and wing responsibilities throughout the season... Recorded several notable performances, including a 27-point outing (Feb 5, 2019) vs Illinois State, a 22-point game (Nov 6, 2018) vs Concordia (IL), and a 17-point performance (Mar 7, 2019) vs Indiana State, showing steady scoring ability across the year... Provided reliable perimeter shooting and defensive activity, averaging 1.8 steals per game while also contributing on the glass from the wing/guard position... Established himself as a dependable rotation starter, offering versatility, energy, and balanced production across all phases of the game.

PERSONAL

He is the son of Deanna Liberty and comes from a strong basketball lineage. His uncle, Marcus Liberty, played collegiate basketball at the University of Illinois from 1988 to 1990 and was a key member of the 1989 Final Four team. Marcus was selected in the second round of the 1990 NBA Draft by the Denver Nuggets and went on to play four seasons in the NBA with the Nuggets and Detroit Pistons.
