PROFESSIONAL CAREER

Averaged 19.6 points, 4.1 rebounds, and 2.9 assists in 30.7 minutes per game during his first professional season with Lahti Basketball (Finland), shooting 47.2% from the field and 42.2% from three-point range... Established himself as a primary scoring option, recording multiple 20+ point performances and demonstrating strong perimeter shooting efficiency... Contributed across multiple categories with solid rebounding, playmaking, and defensive activity, emerging as a reliable and versatile frontcourt presence in a high-usage role.

2025–26 (Finland – Lahti Basketball): Appeared in the 2025–26 season with Lahti Basketball, establishing himself as a high-usage forward and consistent starter, averaging 19.6 points, 4.1 rebounds, and 2.9 assists in 30.7 minutes per game while shooting 47.2% from the field, 42.2% from three-point range, and 72.2% from the free-throw line... Emerged as a primary scoring option, delivering multiple high-level performances, including several 25+ point outings and a season-high 29 points vs. Kouvot (Jan. 14)... Recorded numerous 20+ point games throughout the season, showcasing consistent offensive production and perimeter scoring ability... Added strong all-around performances, including a 28-point, 10-rebound effort vs. Tapiolan Honka (Dec. 19) and a 26-point, 7-rebound, 6-assist game vs. Nilan Bisons (Mar. 18), highlighting his versatility... Demonstrated efficient three-point shooting with multiple high-volume games from beyond the arc, including 7-of-11 vs. Kouvot (Jan. 14) and several 4+ three-point performances... Contributed across multiple statistical categories with steady rebounding, playmaking, and defensive activity, establishing himself as a reliable and versatile frontcourt scorer at the professional level.

UNIVERSITY CAREER

Across his collegiate career at Coastal Alabama South and Tarleton State, Williams developed into a high-usage scoring guard who consistently expanded his role from junior college standout to NCAA Division I contributor. He averaged approximately 11.8 points, 3.8 rebounds, and 1.1 assists per game, shooting around 44% from the field, 35% from three-point range, and 76% from the free-throw line. At Coastal Alabama South (2019–2022), he served as a primary offensive option,

regularly producing 20–30+ point performances and leading his team in scoring, while at Tarleton State (2022–2024), he became a consistent starter and versatile wing, contributing scoring, rebounding, and perimeter shooting against higher-level competition while adapting to a more structured NCAA role.

2023–24 (NCAA – Tarleton State): Appeared in the 2023–24 season with Tarleton State, establishing himself as a consistent starter and versatile wing, averaging 12.9 points, 4.4 rebounds, and 1.3 assists in 33.5 minutes per game while shooting 45.4% from the field, 31.1% from three-point range, and 76.1% from the free-throw line... Delivered multiple standout performances, including 28 points vs. Texas-RGV (Jan. 20), 27 points vs. Stephen F. Austin (Feb. 3), and 25 points vs. Abilene Christian (Feb. 1), along with several 20+ point outings... Showcased strong all-around ability with games such as 16 points and 10 rebounds vs. UNT-Dallas (Nov. 11) and multiple 6–9 rebound performances... Contributed defensively with consistent multi-steal efforts and occasional shot-blocking presence... Demonstrated versatility across SG/SF/PF positions, providing scoring, rebounding, and defensive impact while playing heavy minutes throughout the season.

2022–23 (NCAA – Tarleton State): Appeared in the 2022–23 season with Tarleton State, contributing as a rotational guard with both starting and bench responsibilities, averaging 10.7 points, 3.2 rebounds, and 0.9 assists in 24.8 minutes per game while shooting 43.6% from the field, 41.2% from three-point range, and 77.8% from the free-throw line... Showcased scoring ability with multiple double-digit performances, including a season-high 30 points vs. Huston-Tillotson (Dec. 21) and 25 points vs. Utah Tech (Jan. 26)... Added several strong outings such as 21 points vs. Texas-Arlington (Dec. 29) and consistent 10–15 point performances throughout the season... Demonstrated efficient perimeter shooting with multiple multi-three-point games, highlighting his ability to stretch the floor... Contributed across multiple areas with solid rebounding and defensive activity, while providing scoring and energy in both starting and reserve roles.

2021–22 (Coastal Alabama South): Appeared in the 2021–22 season with Coastal Alabama South, establishing himself as a primary scoring guard and consistent starter... Delivered a highly productive offensive season highlighted by multiple standout performances, including 33 points vs. Lawson State (Dec. 2), 32 points vs. William Carey JV (Nov. 11), and several 25–30 point outings in conference play... Showed consistent scoring efficiency with multiple high-percentage shooting games, including 12-of-18 from the field (Nov. 11) and several games shooting above 60%... Produced strong all-around scoring stretches, regularly contributing 20+ points while serving as the focal point of the offense... Demonstrated ability to score at all three levels while also drawing frequent free-throw opportunities in high-usage situations... Provided steady production throughout the season, combining scoring volume, efficiency, and durability as a full-time starter.

2020–21 (Coastal Alabama South): Appeared in the 2020–21 season with Coastal Alabama South, establishing himself as a primary scoring guard and consistent starter... Averaged strong offensive production throughout the season, highlighted by multiple high-scoring performances including a 34-point game vs. Wallace CC-Selma (Feb. 5), a 30-point outing vs. Lawson State (Apr. 6), and several 20+ point performances across conference play...

Delivered efficient shooting nights, including 13-of-14 from the field (Feb. 5) and multiple games shooting above 50% from the floor while also contributing as a reliable three-point shooter... Showcased versatility as a scorer, attacking all three levels with multiple games of 4–6 made threes and consistent free-throw efficiency... Produced several all-around performances with double-digit scoring in nearly every game, while also contributing in rebounding effort and late-game production... Demonstrated durability and high usage as a full-time starter, playing heavy minutes and serving as a focal point of the offense throughout the season.

2019–20 (Coastal Alabama South): Appeared during the 2019–20 season with Coastal Alabama South, contributing as a scoring guard with both starting and bench responsibilities... Showed strong offensive flashes throughout the year, recording multiple high-scoring performances including 30 points vs. Pensacola State (Nov. 2), 27 points vs. Lurleen B. Wallace CC (Feb. 17), and 25 points vs. Wallace CC-Selma (Feb. 13)... Added several 20+ point outings, demonstrating consistent scoring ability and confidence as a perimeter threat... Displayed efficient shooting in multiple games, including 10-of-12 shooting (Feb. 17) and 6-of-7 shooting (Feb. 3), along with multiple strong three-point performances... Contributed on the glass with several double-digit rebound efforts... Demonstrated versatility and offensive upside, providing scoring bursts, perimeter shooting, and energy while continuing to develop his all-around game.

PERSONAL

Lou Williams is a developing basketball guard known for his scoring instincts and competitive play at the junior college/collegiate level. A hard-working backcourt player, he has built his game around offensive versatility, energy, and toughness on both ends of the floor. Williams has competed across various prep and collegiate environments, continuing to develop his skill set as a combo guard. Off the court, he is focused on improving his game and advancing his basketball career at the next level.
