2025–26 (NBA G League): Appeared in 4 games with the Grand Rapids Gold during the 2025–26 season, averaging 2.8 points, 1.8 rebounds, and 1.0 assist in 8.1 minutes per game... Made his debut against the Birmingham Squadron (Mar. 11)... Recorded 5 points, 3 rebounds, and 2 assists versus the South Bay Lakers (Mar. 20)... Added 6 points on an efficient 2-of-4 shooting, including a perfect 2-of-2 from three-point range, along with 3 rebounds and 2 assists in a win over the Birmingham Squadron (Mar. 27)... Provided backcourt depth in a reserve role, showing the ability to space the floor and contribute as a secondary playmaker in limited minutes.

UNIVERSITY CAREER

Appeared in 66 games with Penn State (NCAA, 2016–2018), averaging 16.5 points, 4.9 rebounds, and 4.6 assists in approximately 34 minutes per game, while establishing himself as one of the team's primary offensive engines. Amassed 1,094 points, 327 rebounds, and 305 assists over his collegiate career, demonstrating consistent production and a strong ability to score and create for teammates, with multiple standout performances including numerous 25+ point games and a 25-point, 14-assist outing in the NCAA Tournament.

2017–18 (NCAA – Penn State): Appeared in 34 games with Penn State, averaging 19.6 points, 4.9 rebounds, and 5.0 assists in 35.3 minutes per game while shooting 40.8% from the field... Opened the season with 33 points and 9 rebounds against Campbell (Nov. 10)... Added 31 points on efficient shooting against Texas A&M (Nov. 21)... Recorded 29 points versus NC State (Nov. 29)... Posted 28 points against Indiana (Jan. 9)... Delivered a 30-point performance against Ohio State (Feb. 15)... Added 33 points and 6 rebounds against Minnesota (Jan. 15)... Recorded 28 points against Michigan State (Jan. 31)... Contributed 27 points versus Nebraska (Feb. 25)... Tallied 25 points against Marquette (Mar. 20)... PERSONAL

Anthony Gregory Carr is the son of Anthony and Nicole Carr and has two brothers, Derek Carr and Khalief Tinley, and one sister, Ciara Robinson... Born October 11, 1997 in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania... A highly decorated guard prior to his collegiate career, he was ranked No. 50 in the ESPN Top 100 and rated as a four-star recruit, as well as the top-ranked player in Pennsylvania... Named the 2016 Pennsylvania Player of the Year by *USA Today* and earned multiple All-State and All-Philadelphia honors during his high school career... Helped lead Roman Catholic to back-to-back PIAA AAAA State Championships alongside Nazeer Bostick and Lamar Stevens, while also competing with AAU program Team Final, where he led the team in assists and finished second in scoring behind Stevens... Continued his success at Penn State, developing into one of the Big Ten's top players and earning honors including All-Big Ten First Team (2018), AP All-American Honorable Mention, and multiple all-tournament selections, before later being recognized internationally as the Italian Lega A Best Player Under 22 in 2019.
