PROFESSIONAL CAREER

Appeared in 72 professional games with the Grand Rapids Gold in the NBA G-League and the House of Talents Kortrijk Spurs in the BNXT League... Averaged 10.0 points, 2.4 rebounds, and 37% from three-point range... Known for consistent perimeter shooting and being an efficient scorer, Horton has recorded multiple games scoring 20 or more points in both the BNXT League and NBA G League, including season-highs of 30 points (House of Talents Kortrijk Spurs, 2025–26) and 23 points (Grand Rapids Gold, 2024-25), while providing reliable two-way play and valuable experience from a FIBA international league.

2025-26 (House of Talents Kortrijk Spurs – BNXT League)

Signed first overseas professional contract with the House of Talents Kortrijk Spurs in BNXT League (Belgian-Dutch League) (Nov. 24, 2025)... Averaged 14.4 points, 3.4 rebounds, 39.5% from three-point territory, and 87.% from the free-throw line in 28 games (2 starts)... Led the team in scoring whilst coming off the bench (14.4 points per game)... Ranked second on the team in total points scored with 396 points... Scored 20 or more points in 8 games... Put up a season-high 30 points (9-of-11 shooting inside the arc, 5 for 7 shooting beyond the arc), a perfect 7-of-7 from the free-throw line, and secured 4 rebounds in a victory versus Basketball Academie Limburg (Feb. 18) played 22 minutes... Finished second on team in points-per-possession (1.094 points-per-possession)... Delivered 15 points (5-of-12 shooting) and 5 rebounds in first start of season versus Den Helder Suns (Jan. 11)... Was the offensive engine for House of Talents Kortrijk Spurs, helping secure a 24 win 10 loss record, good for fourth best in the league.

2024-25 (Grand Rapids Gold – NBA G-League)

Signed first professional contract after playing at Texas... Began professional career with the Grand Rapids Gold, in NBA G-League, appeared in 44 games (Fourth most on team) games and averaged 5.7 points, 1.4 rebounds, and shooting 34.4% from three-point range on 2.9 attempts per match while playing 14.7 minutes per... In rookie season, scored double-digit points in 9 contests... Scored season-high 23 points (9-of-17 field goal, 5-of-8 three-point) versus Birmingham Squadron (Mar. 8), adding 3 assists and 3 steals... Participated in the NBA G-League Tip-Off Tournament, played in 11 games playing 13.3

minutes per... Notched 19 points (8-of-3 field goals, 50% from beyond the arc), 6 rebounds, 3 assists, and 2 steals versus Osceola Magic (Feb. 10).

COLLEGIATE CAREER

Finished his collegiate career with 1,377 points while suiting up for the University of Texas, University of Central Florida, University of Pittsburgh, and University of Delaware... Established himself as one of the top three-point shooters in the Atlantic Coast Conference during his time at Pittsburgh... Began his collegiate career by being selected to the Coastal Athletic Association All-Rookie team and multiple Coastal Athletic Association Rookie of the Week selections... Averaged 10.1 points, 3.0 rebounds, 1.4 assists, while shooting a cumulative 37.2% from three-point territory throughout NCAA career... Appeared in the NCAA Tournament and helped the Texas Longhorns reach the Round of 32 in his final collegiate season.

2023-24 (Senior Year – University of Texas)

Decided to transfer to Texas following the 2022-23 season... In senior year, played 34 games (16 starts), averaged 5.9 points, 2.7 rebounds, shooting 35.1% from beyond the arc and 71.9% from the free-throw line in 20.1 minutes per game... Scored double-digit points in 10 occasions... Posted first career double-double against Texas-Arlington in a win 62-79 (Jan. 1), notched 13 points while securing 10 rebounds (3 offensive, 7 defensive)... Registered 14 points (6-of-9 field goals) and 5 rebounds versus Kansas State in Big 12 conference championship second-round... Made NCAA post-season tournament for the first time in career, matched up versus Colorado State in Round of 64... Last collegiate game versus Tennessee (Mar. 23) in Round of 32.

2022-23 (Senior Year – University of Central Florida)

Started all 34 of the Knight's games (1 of 2 to do so in 2022-23)... Averaged 12.3 points, 3.7 rebounds, and a team-leading 2.3 three-point makes in 30.9 minutes per contest... Scored the 1,000 career point in NCAA on Jan 25 versus Houston, scored 18 points total, leading all Knights' scorers... Led team in three-pointers made with 78 (78 for 224)... Finished 6th in AAC in total three-pointers made... Netted 83.3% of free throws attempted (40-48), the second best on the team... Secured a career-high nine rebounds in season opener against UNC Asheville (Nov. 7)... Stole the basketball six times versus Tusla (Feb. 26) setting a new career-high in steals... Tallied double-digit points in 22 of the Knight's 34 games, 15-or-more in 11 games... Appeared in NIT Tournament in 2023 beating the Florida Gators (Mar. 15) and losing in the second-round against Oregon (Mar. 19).

2021-22 (Junior Year – University of Pittsburgh)

Played 13 games (8 starts) and averaged 9.8 points, 2.7 rebounds, shooting 36% from the field... Went 25 of 66 (37.9%) from three-point range... In season debut scored 13 points accompanied by 4 rebounds in 28 minutes, making 3 of his 5 three-point attempts versus Louisville (Jan. 5)... Became the eighth player in Pittsburgh history to shoot 100% from three-point range in a game (min. 5 attempts)... Pittsburgh career-high 25 points with 5

rebounds versus Florida State (Feb. 16), shot 7 for 13 from beyond the arc (season-high), grabbed 5 rebounds.

2020-21 (Sophomore Year – University of Pittsburgh)

Earning the opportunity to transfer to the ACC, joining the Pittsburgh Panthers program... Appearing in 22 games (18 starts), averaged 8.9 points, 2.3 rebounds, 1.3 assists, and making 2 three-pointers per outing... Made team-high 43 three-pointers... Ranked 10th among ACC players in three-point percentage (min. 2 attempts per game)... Scored a season-high 20 points (7-of-12 field goal), with 5 three-pointers in a win versus Syracuse (Jan. 16)... Recorded 10 points (4-of-8 field goal) versus Miami (FL) in the first round of the ACC Tournament (Mar. 9)... Developed into one of the ACC's best three-point shooters.

2019-20 (Redshirt Year)

Sat out the 2019-20 due to NCAA transfer rules.

2018-19 (Freshman Year – University of Delaware)

Began his collegiate career at the University of Delaware with the Fightin' Blue Hens' program... Averaged 13.2 points, 3.1 rebounds, and 1.5 assists in 32.6 minutes across 33 games while shooting 40.9% from beyond the three-point line... Led Delaware with 79 three-pointers, sixth most in a Fightin' Blue Hens' season... Led all CAA freshmen in scoring, earning a spot on the CAA All-Rookie Team... Posted a season-high 31 points, shooting 9 for 13 (School record) from three-point range, in 34 minutes against UNC Wilmington (Jan. 1).
