Hit game-winning shot and finished with a team-high 19 points to lead Independent South 1 to OFSAA AAAA championship with a 76-75 win over Toronto Public at 2013 Ryerson Rams Battle of the Boards. Named Most Valuable Player at 2013 Battle of the Boards. Was a standout for CIA Bounce, a notable Amateur Athletic Union (AAU) program. Chose to reclassify to class of 2013 and sign with Oregon State. Ranked as the 116th prospect in the Class of 2014 and a three-star recruit by Rivals.com. Helped lead Oregon State University to its first appearance in the March Madness NCAA Division I men's basketball tournament since 1990. Won bronze with Team Canada at 2011 U16 FIBA Americas Championships. Finished fifth with Team Canada at 2012 U17 FIBA World Championships. Named Tournament MVP at U17 Canadian Championships.
