PROFESSIONAL CAREER

Contributed across multiple professional seasons in Austria, Hungary, Lithuania, Germany, and Argentina, averaging 12.1 points, 7.1 rebounds, and 1.7 assists in 23.1 minutes per game with SBB Baskets Wolmirstedt during the 2025–26 season while shooting 55.0% from the field, following a 2023–24 campaign in which he averaged 9.2 points, 5.7 rebounds, and 1.8 assists in 19.8 minutes per game across multiple leagues while maintaining 54.6% shooting and showcasing versatility in both starting and bench roles. Previously posted a career-best season in 2022–23 with Kaposvári KK, averaging 15.2 points, 8.5 rebounds, 2.3 assists, 1.3 steals, and 1.9 blocks in 29.7 minutes per game on 58.9% shooting while starting every game and establishing himself as a dominant two-way frontcourt presence, while in 2021–22 with BC Hallmann Vienna, averaged 10.7 points and 7.3 rebounds in 22.8 minutes per game on 63.8% shooting, consistently providing efficient interior scoring, rebounding, and defensive impact as a reliable contributor across multiple international leagues.

2025–26 (Germany – ProA): Appeared in 22 games with SBB Baskets Wolmirstedt during the 2025–26 season, averaging 12.1 points, 7.1 rebounds, and 1.7 assists in 23.1 minutes per game while shooting an efficient 55.0% from the field... Opened the season with 13 points, 10 rebounds, and 4 blocks against BBC Bayreuth (Nov. 7)... Added 12 points on 4-of-6 shooting versus Nürnberg Falcons (Nov. 14)... Recorded 20 points on 6-of-10 shooting against Bayer Giants Leverkusen (Dec. 19)... Delivered a dominant 23-point, 12-rebound performance versus VfL SparkassenStars Bochum (Dec. 27)... 2023–24 (Argentina/Germany/Lithuania): Appeared in multiple competitions across Argentina, Germany, and Lithuania, showcasing versatility and adaptability at the professional level... Averaged 9.2 points, 5.7 rebounds, and 1.8 assists in 19.8 minutes per game while shooting an efficient 54.6% from the field... With Ciclista Olímpico (Argentina – LNB), recorded several strong performances as a starting center... Opened a productive stretch with 20 points, 11 rebounds, and 4 blocks against Comunicaciones Mercedes (Apr. 28)... Followed up with 18 points and 11 rebounds versus Obras Sanitarias (Apr. 24)... Started in all appearances, showcasing versatility between the power forward and center positions... Opened the season with 12 points and 5 rebounds versus Szolnoki Olaj (Oct. 1)... Delivered a dominant performance with 23 points and 10 rebounds against Zalakerámia-ZTE KK (Oct. 22)... Recorded a season-high 24 points on 11-of-14 shooting against KTE-Duna Aszfalt (Dec. 3)... Posted 19 points, 14 rebounds, and 6 assists in a well-rounded performance versus Atomerőmű SE (Oct. 11)... Opened the season with 12 points and 9 rebounds against St. Pölten (Oct. 16)... Added 16 points on a perfect 8-of-8 shooting performance versus Kapfenberg (Dec. 4)... UNIVERSITY CAREER

2020–21 (NCAA – Duquesne): Appeared in 18 games with Duquesne University, averaging 10.8 points, 7.9 rebounds, 2.1 assists, 1.0 steals, and 1.6 blocks in 27.1 minutes per game while shooting 51.0% from the field, serving as a consistent two-way presence in the frontcourt and contributing as both a starter and off the bench. Recorded multiple strong performances throughout the season, including 20 points and 9-of-16 shooting against Richmond (Feb. 20)... 15 points and 10 rebounds versus St. Bonaventure (Mar. 5)... 13 points, 14 rebounds, and 2 assists against Dayton (Feb. 2)... and 12 points, 5 assists, and 3 blocks versus George Washington (Jan. 2)... while providing steady rebounding, interior scoring, and rim protection on both ends of the floor.

2019–20 (NCAA – Duquesne): Appeared in 31 games with Duquesne University, averaging 10.3 points, 6.8 rebounds, 1.6 assists, 1.5 steals, and 2.7 blocks in 24.5 minutes per game while shooting 57.3% from the field, serving as a dominant interior presence and consistent starter throughout the season. Delivered multiple standout performances, including 23 points on 10-of-11 shooting against Virginia Military (Dec. 4)... 19 points and 7 rebounds versus Dayton (Jan. 29)... 18 points, 7 rebounds, and 3 blocks against St. Bonaventure (Feb. 26)... and 14 points, 8 rebounds, and 2 blocks against VCU (Mar. 3)... while consistently impacting the game with efficient scoring, strong rebounding, and elite rim protection on both ends of the floor.

2018–19 (NCAA – Duquesne): Appeared in 29 games with Duquesne University, averaging 11.2 points, 6.5 rebounds, 0.9 assists, 0.9 steals, and 2.3 blocks in 24.2 minutes per game while shooting 58.9% from the field, serving as a primary interior presence and consistent starter throughout the season. Delivered multiple strong performances, including 21 points and 14 rebounds against George Washington (Jan. 20)... 20 points and 10 rebounds versus Pittsburgh (Nov. 30)... 20 points against Marshall (Dec. 5)... and 17 points and 9 rebounds against Massachusetts (Mar. 2)... while consistently providing efficient scoring, strong rebounding, and rim protection on both ends of the floor.

2016–17 (NCAA – Akron): Appeared in 19 games with the University of Akron, averaging 1.8 points and 1.2 rebounds in 7.3 minutes per game while shooting 45.8% from the field, contributing primarily in a reserve role while gaining early collegiate experience across limited minutes. Provided energy and defensive effort in a bench role, recording a season-high 6 points against Adrian (Nov. 30)... And contributing across multiple appearances with rebounds, steals, and interior presence while developing within the program.

Michael Hughes II is a professional basketball player who developed his game from an early age and emerged as one of the top high school players in the Kansas City area. He is the son of Robbie-Joe and Michael Hughes I. He attended Liberty North High School in Missouri, where he established himself as a standout performer and earned multiple conference, district, and state-level honors throughout his career. A key contributor throughout his high school career, Hughes helped lead Liberty North to multiple district championships while gaining recognition for his consistency, work ethic, and impact on both ends of the floor. He continued his basketball career at the collegiate level before advancing to the professional ranks. Hughes is known for his presence in the frontcourt, his defensive impact, and his ability to contribute as a versatile and reliable team player.
