PROFESSIONAL CAREER

Contributed across multiple professional seasons in Canada, Finland, Italy, and Hungary. Appearing in 162 professional games with the Brampton Honey Badgers in the CEBL, Korihait in Korisliiga, HARKO Merlins Crailsheim in G-BBL, Elachem Vigevano in Italy Serie A2, and Atomeromu SE in NBIA ... Averaged 7.5 points, 5.76 rebounds, and 49.6% from the field... Known for physical rebounding, being a tactical screener, and a high-motor player, Oduro has recorded multiple games with double-doubles (24 games), including a career-high of 16 rebounds (Elachem Vigevano, 2023-24) and 15 rebounds (Korihait, 2022-23)... Providing reliable rim protection, physical defence, and hard-nosed rebounding, whilst providing valuable FIBA experience across multiple levels.

2025-26 (Brampton Honey Badgers - CEBL)

Signed for his fifth season as a Honey Badger, Oduro returns for 11 games, starting 6, before being released by the club... Averaged 5.4 points and 5 rebounds in 19.9 minutes... Helped Brampton begin their season with 7 wins and 1 defeat... Highlighted by a 10-point, 7-rebound performance against Montreal Alliance (May 28)... Most recently had 3 points, 7 rebounds, and 1 steal against Scarborough Shooting Stars (June 27)... Added 10 points (5-for-8 shooting) and grabbed 7 rebounds against Vancouver Bandits (June 20)... Oduro plans to finish the season with Montreal Alliance.

2024-25 (Elachem Vigevano - Serie A2, Atomeromu SE - NBIA, Brampton Honey Badgers - CEBL)

Signed with Elachem Vigevano in the Italian Serie A2, averaging 11.1 points, 8.4 rebounds, and 27.7 minutes in 19 games played, registering 19 starts... Led team in rebounds per outing with 8.4, as well as finished fourth in scoring per game at 11.1... Double-digit scoring games in 12 matches... Including performances such as his 18 points and 11 rebounds versus Pallacanestro Orzinuovi (Nov 13)... Added 17 points on an efficient 61.5% shooting with 16 rebounds in a win versus UCC Assifeco Piacenza... Debuted with 17 points (6-for-10 shooting) and 7 rebounds (3 offensive and 4 defensive) against Ferraroni Juvi Cremona... After his stint in Italy, moved on to Atomeromu SE in Hungarian NBIA... Continued to lead the rebounding category with a team-high 8.3 per game... Contributed 1.5 blocks per outing, another team-high... Totalled 12 points (6-for-7 shooting), 14 rebounds, and protected the

rim effectively with 4 blocks in 32 minutes in a victory over DEAC... Played his final match in Hungary with a win over Egis Kormend (Mar. 26), contributing 9 points and 8 rebounds... Signed with Brampton Honey Badgers again for fourth season with club... Played in 23 games, starting 22 of them, putting up 9.2 points, 6 rebounds, 1 assist, and 1.1 blocks per game in 25 minutes... Filled up box scores often, with 5 double-doubles on the season, tied for first on the Honey Badgers' squad... Notable performances such as a win over Scarborough Shooting Stars where Oduro contributed 17 points, 10 rebounds, a career-high 6 assists, and 3 blocks (July 25)... Demonstrated consistent interior scoring, strong rebounding presence, and rim protection.

2023-24 (HARKO Merlins Crailsheim - G-BBL, Brampton Honey Badgers - CEBL)

Appeared in 20 games with HARKO Merlins Crailsheim during the 2023–24 season, averaging 4.4 points and 3.6 rebounds in 15 minutes per game... Opened the season with 13 (6-for-10 field goals) points, 6 rebounds against ALBA Berlin (Oct 2)... Had a strong performance in the German Cup competition with 17 points in 32 minutes, while securing 8 rebounds in a matchup versus Giessen 46ers (Sept 23)... Scored 10 points on 80% shooting in 19 minutes against Basketball Lowen Braunschweig (Jan 20)... Returned to the Brampton Honey Badgers for third season... Suited up for 9 contests, totalling 9.3 points, 7.1 rebounds and 1.6 assists... Starting in eight of nine matches... Delivered 19 points, 6 rebounds, and a 2-block performance versus the Ottawa Blackjacks (July 10)... Added 9 points and 12 rebounds versus Niagara River Lions (July 17). Provided efficient interior scoring and physical rebounding production throughout the summer, contributing in a starting role.

2022-23 (Korihait - Korisliiga, Brampton Honey Badgers - CEBL)

Appeared in both Finland and Canada... Averaged 11.0 points, 7.3 rebounds, 1.1 blocks in 23.9 minutes per contest across 52 games... Started the year with Korihait (Finland - Korisliiga), playing in all 32 games (24 starts)... Totaled 12.4 points and led the team in rebounding with 7.8 per game... Was the second most efficient scorer on the team, making 53.3% of shots... Scored 20 or more points on three occasions... Had a career-high 22 points (7-for-10 shooting) along with 7 rebounds in a massive victory versus Tapiolan Honka (Feb 4)... Prior to that game, notched 19 points (8-for-13 field goals) with 12 total rebounds against BC Nokia (Feb 1)... Had seven double-doubles in the campaign, team-high... Contributed a team-high 20 points and 10 rebounds against Kobrat (Feb 18)... After the season concluded, returned to Canada to rejoin the Brampton Honey Badgers (Canada - CEBL)... Played in 20 games (1-of-2 to do so in the 2022-23 campaign), averaging 8.6 points, 6.6 rebounds, defending the rim with 1.1 blocks... Continued two-way presence with four double-doubles... Highlighted by a 17-point (8-for-11 shooting), 12-rebound performance against Ottawa Blackjacks (May 24)... Grabbed 14 rebounds and 15 points versus Saskatchewan Rattlers in 35 minutes (Mar. 2)... Finished with double-digit points in 10 games. Provided reliable production as both a starter and off the bench, recording multiple double-digit scoring performances while impacting the game on both ends of the floor.

2021-22 (Brampton Honey Badgers – CEBL)

Signed first professional contract after NCAA career... Began professional career with the

Brampton Honey Badgers in Canada's top division, appeared in 21 games and averaged 5.2 points, 4.5 rebounds, and shooting 47.2% from the field... Played 19.3 minutes per game, had a pivotal role off the bench for the Honey Badgers... Had first career double-double against the Ottawa Blackjacks, scoring a season-high 14 points (6-for-10 field goals) and securing 10 rebounds (8 offensive) in a win (July 2)... Had 9 points in a win versus the Newfoundland Growlers (3-for-5 shooting) (June 16)... Finished third on the team in field goal percentage with 47.2%... Led the Honey Badgers in blocks with 17.

COLLEGIATE CAREER

Finished his collegiate career with 388 points, appearing in 77 matches for the University of Detroit Mercy, University of South Florida, Mississippi State University, and Siena University... Carved out his role as a premium rebounder and a hard screen setter... Began his collegiate career by being selected to the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference All-Rookie team... Equaled 5.0 points and 2.1 rebounds, while hitting 48.1% of field goals throughout his NCAA career.

2021-22 (Senior Year – University of Detroit Mercy)

Appeared in 8 contests and started in 6... Averaged 5.1 points, 4 rebounds, 20.9 minutes per game... Notched a season-best 14 points on 7-for-7 shooting along with 7 rebounds in a matchup against Mississippi State (Nov 17)... Grabbed 8 rebounds versus Illinois-Chicago (Dec 5) in his final collegiate game.

2020-21 (Junior Year – University of South Florida)

Played in 17 games and averaged 2.3 points and 2.1 rebounds per outing... Scored a season-high eight points and retrieved five rebounds at Wichita State (March 6)... Had six points and four rebounds against Temple in the opening round of the AAC Tournament (March 11)... Finished with six points and three rebounds in a victory over Florida College in his Bulls debut (Nov. 25).

2019-20 (Sophomore Year – Mississippi State University)

Saw action in 21 games off the bench where he averaged 1.2 points and 0.9 rebounds per game ... Scored points in six of his 11 non-conference appearances... First point as a Bulldog came on a free throw versus Louisiana-Monroe (Nov. 14)... Notched three points and a season's best four rebounds against New Orleans (Nov. 17)... Recorded a season-high six points and three rebounds versus Tulane (Nov. 21)... Best SEC outing was two points and two rebounds versus Missouri (Jan. 14) ... Entered transfer portal following 2019-20 season.

2018-19 (Redshirt Year)

Sat out the 2019-20 season due to NCAA transfer rules.

2017-18 (Freshman Year – Siena University)

Spent his freshman season at Siena University with the Saints’ program... Averaged 9.1 points and 5.1 rebounds in 25.6 minutes across 31 games while starting in 27 of the Saints’ games... Was a 2017-18 All-Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) Rookie Team selection... Led team in total points (276) and total rebounds (153)... Scored a career-high 19 points against Niagara (Jan 5)... Secured a season-high 12 rebounds, 3 offensive and 9 defensive, in 35 minutes against Manhattan (Feb 2).
