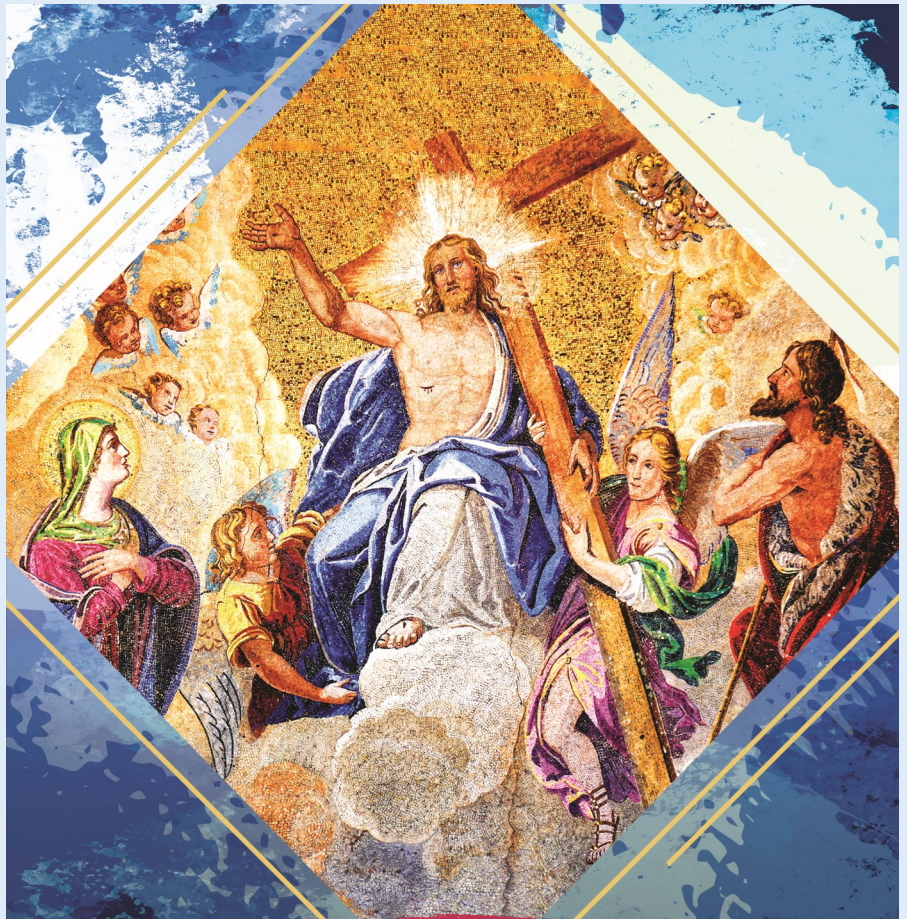

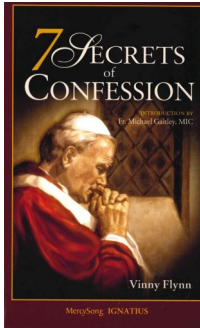

Birthright Baby Shower Fundraiser - Now Thru March 24th

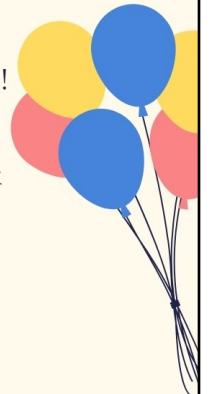

The Columbiettes are having an initiation ceremony at 12:00 noon on March 17th in the large classroom. Guests are welcome.

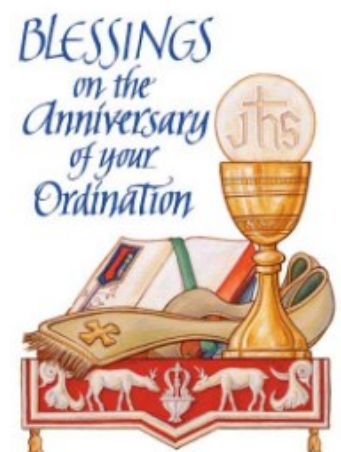
