

We have 9 students participating in this year's Confirmation Class led by Rose Presutti & Daniel Wallick. We look forward to having them confirmed on Wednesday, February 11, 2026.

I had the Opening Day Parents/Grandparents/Children/Teachers meeting in the Large Classroom last Sunday to open up the first day of class. The children are so eager to learn about Jesus and their faith. After the introduction of the teachers, off the children went to class. The parents remained, and I must say, I am so VERY GRATEFUL to all of them for the love, care, support and sacrifices they make. The teachers are constantly telling me how wonderful and well-behaved the children are. Children learn what they live, and these children are learning they are loved by their parents, teachers, and parish community.

I have thrown out a challenge to the parents (and I will welcome the entire parish to participate) that they add ONE habit to their home within the next 10 weeks to make it more Christ-Centered. This could be saying Grace before meals, a decade or a whole Rosary once a week as a family, going to Adoration, attending Daily Mass, lighting a candle and saying a prayer for someone, saying night/bedtime prayers, giving the child a blessing each morning before they go to school. The list is endless. Just ONE habit every 10 weeks, so that will be three faithful habits to make Christ a priority in their home, in addition to attending Mass/CCD weekly. "Start children off on the way they should go, and even when they are old they will not turn from it." — Proverbs 22:6

I look forward to watching the children grow and have a relationship with Jesus. Thank you all for being a part of the children's faith journey.
