





Casserole Sale Proceeds Are Donated!

The Columbiette Casserole Sale was a huge success! The Columbiettes wish to thank every person who made monetary donations, made casseroles, soups, chili, or other foods to be sold, or purchased our delicious items. In total, the Columbiettes raised \$3,002. As is customary, fifty percent (\$1,501) of the proceeds will be donated to Transfiguration Catholic Church Operations. At the December Business Meeting, the Columbiettes selected two Transfiguration ministries to receive the other 50%:



The Grounds and Building Maintenance Ministry will receive \$750.50. The ministry is overseen by Dan Medina and Adger Brown. This ministry needs a new leaf blower, and they would like to replace the two benches at the entrance of the church, as they have been repaired several times and continue to deteriorate. A dedication plate could be placed on one of the benches if desired.

Transfiguration Youth Group Ministry will also receive \$750.50. The ministry is overseen by Michelle Powell. This ministry wants to buy one or two more picnic tables and additional outdoor seating for the old grill area. They are serving approximately forty youth at each meeting and more space is needed. Any leftover money would be spent on replacing sports equipment used for games and as educational aids.




