



THE FIRST SUNDAY OF LENT

FEBRUARY 22, 2026

During Lent, I know how tempting it can be to focus on the external practices—fasting, abstaining, attending Stations of the Cross—and forget why Jesus calls us to these disciplines. He came to teach us the deeper reasons for faith, to help us grow closer to God and one another, not to simply check off boxes or follow rituals for their own sake. I imagine Jesus, at the beginning of His ministry, withdrawing to the wilderness—a place so desolate and challenging that it was known as the Devastation. He needed that time alone, away from distractions, to prepare for the immense task ahead. As I reflect on my own experiences, I realize how important it is to carve out moments of quiet and contemplation, especially in the midst of a busy life, to reconnect with what truly matters.

The temptations Jesus faced in the desert speak powerfully to me. Like Him, I've felt the urge to use my gifts for my own benefit rather than for others, to seek signs or proof instead of trusting in God's quiet presence, and to compromise my values for the sake of comfort or acceptance. Each time I struggle with these temptations, I try to remember Jesus' example: to be selfless in sharing what I have, to nurture faith that doesn't depend on dramatic signs, and to stand firm in what I believe even when it's difficult.

What strikes me most is that Jesus shared this story with His disciples—He wanted us to know that we, too, will be tested, and that He understands our struggles. As I move through this Lenten Season, I want to follow His example by stepping back from the distractions around me, focusing on the virtues of Faith, Hope, and Love, and remembering that the “why” behind our actions gives true purpose and meaning to everything we do. Let us, together, seek that deeper connection with God, and allow our faith to be strengthened by the challenges we face, just as Jesus was strengthened in the wilderness.

ATTENTION 2026-2027 9TH GRADERS New Confirmation Schedule!

When: March 8th! Due to the early Confirmation dates we have been assigned by the office of the Bishop, the 26/27 Confirmation Class will begin on March 8th with a Parent-Student meeting at 9:00 am in the Red Brick Building.

Who: Anyone who will start the 26/27 school year as a 9th, 10th, 11th, or 12th grader, and who has not been Confirmed is welcome to join in this new class.

How: Please fill out the form found on the round table in the Gathering Space to register your students for the new Confirmation preparation classes. **Registration forms are due by March 1st.** Copies of Baptism and First Communion Certificates are required if not already on file in the parish office.

Why: Beginning in March will allow your student to receive a full and unhurried education in preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation. We plan to have ten or so classes, take a summer break, and then return with the rest of Religious Education to complete the formation process.

Cost: \$30, which covers the cost of the 3 books that will be provided to your student and provides online access to the video segments if your child has to miss a class.

The ‘Angel Statue’ and ‘St. Patrick’s Statue’ recently installed in St. Patrick’s Catholic Cemetery located at 1201 Mason Road, Columbia, SC. The cemetery is very close to our parish. Directions from Transfiguration are south on Wilson Blvd (Hwy 21), cross Interstate 20, take the first right (past Pepsi plant and apartment complex) onto Mason Rd, St. Patrick’s Catholic Cemetery is approximately ¼ mile on the right.



Bishop Jacques Fabre-Jeune is planning to bless these two statues on Monday, March 9th, at 4PM.


A small reception, on site, is planned following the blessing and all are invited and encouraged to attend.

The Angel Statue proposal was initiated by the Knights and Columbiettes, Transfiguration Council 13713. The ‘Angel Statue’ is to serve and identify an area in St. Patrick’s where babies are buried and to provide an icon for all to pause and pray with their loved ones and those present. The inscriptions surrounding the statue were provided by Transfiguration Knights and Columbiettes members. The statue was purchased thru contributions

from Knights and Columbiettes Council 13713, Knights of Columbus Assembly (4th/Patriotic Degree) 2902, Knights of Columbus Council (St. John Neumann) 6847 and other contribution from members of parishes.

The St. Patrick’s Statue was initiated by the Diocese of Charleston and purchased thru donations of families who have loved ones interned in St. Patrick’s. The inscriptions are presented by the Diocese of Charleston. Both statues were installed by Diocese personnel and Knight of Columbus Council 13713.
