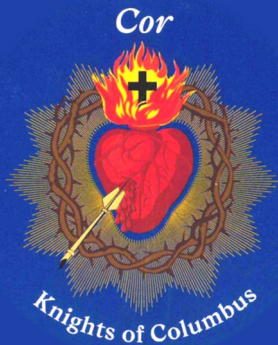

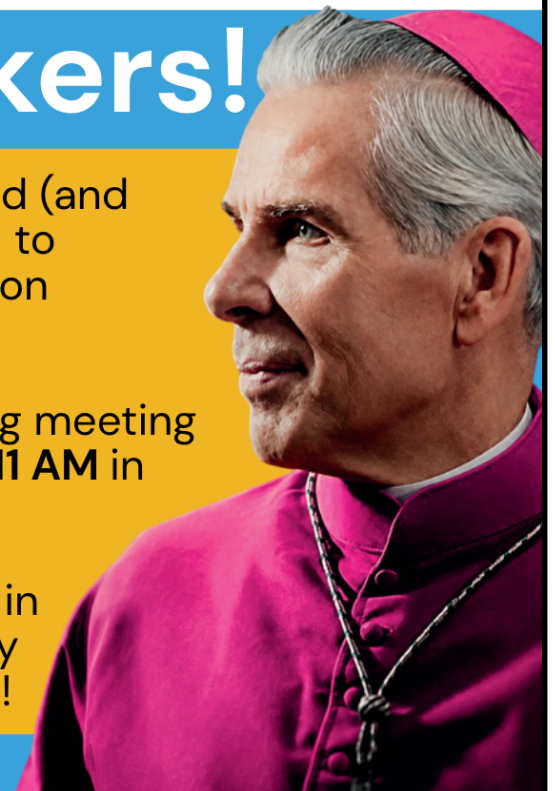

Are you like **Isaiah** or **Samuel**? Will you answer the call?

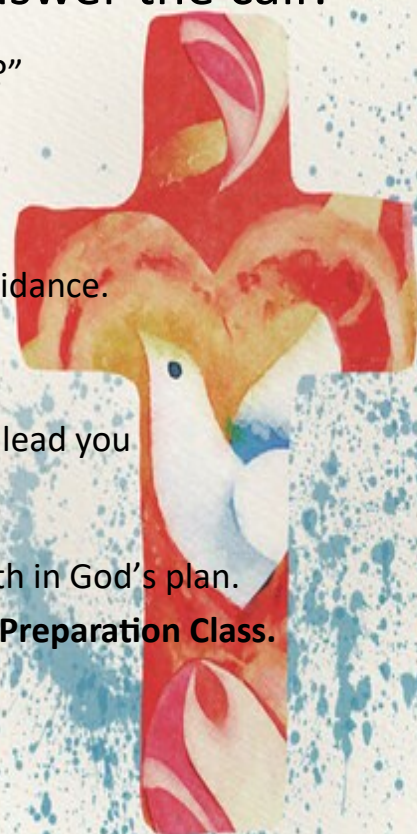
Isaiah 6:8, God asks, "Whom shall I send? And who will go for us?" and Isaiah responds, "**Here am I. Send me!**"

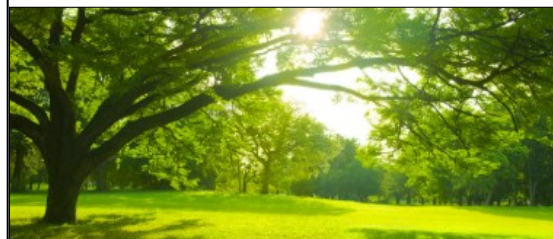
Saint Patrick's Catholic Cemetery Workday

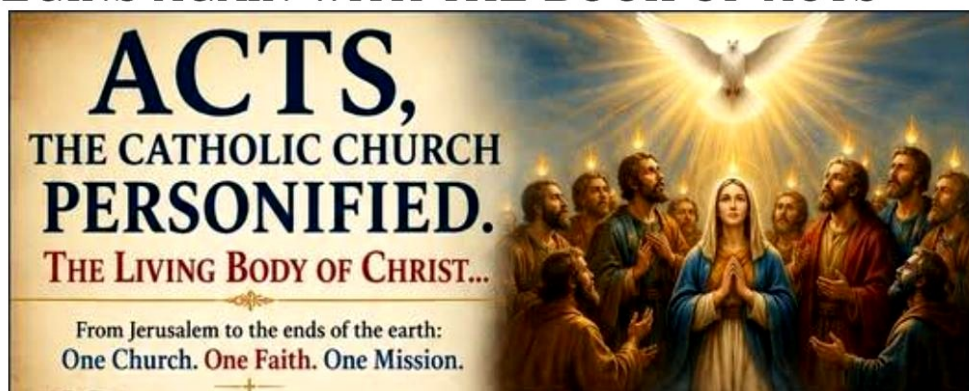

Many of you were able to attend our first gathering this past spring. We hope that it was moving for you and you want to come back and do it again. It takes just over an hour.

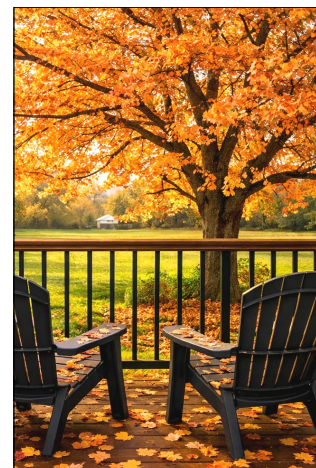

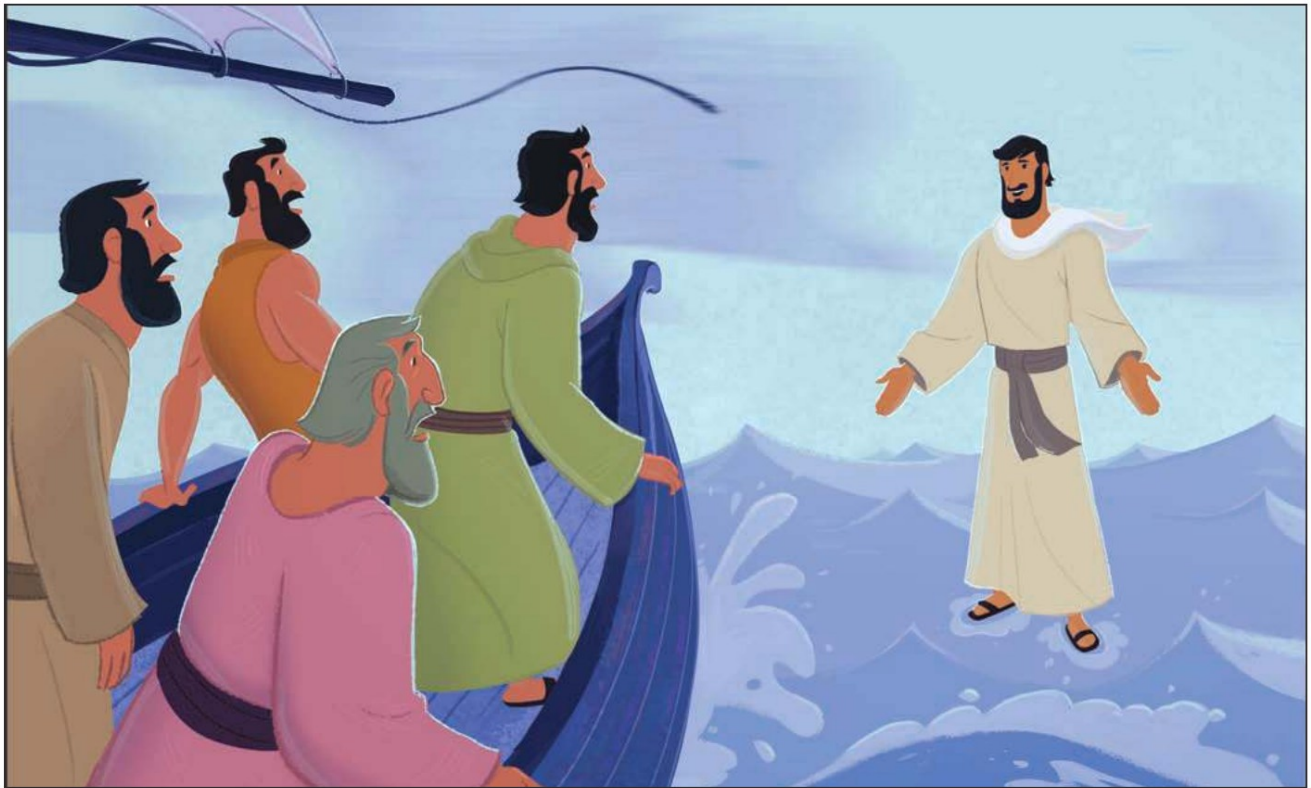
