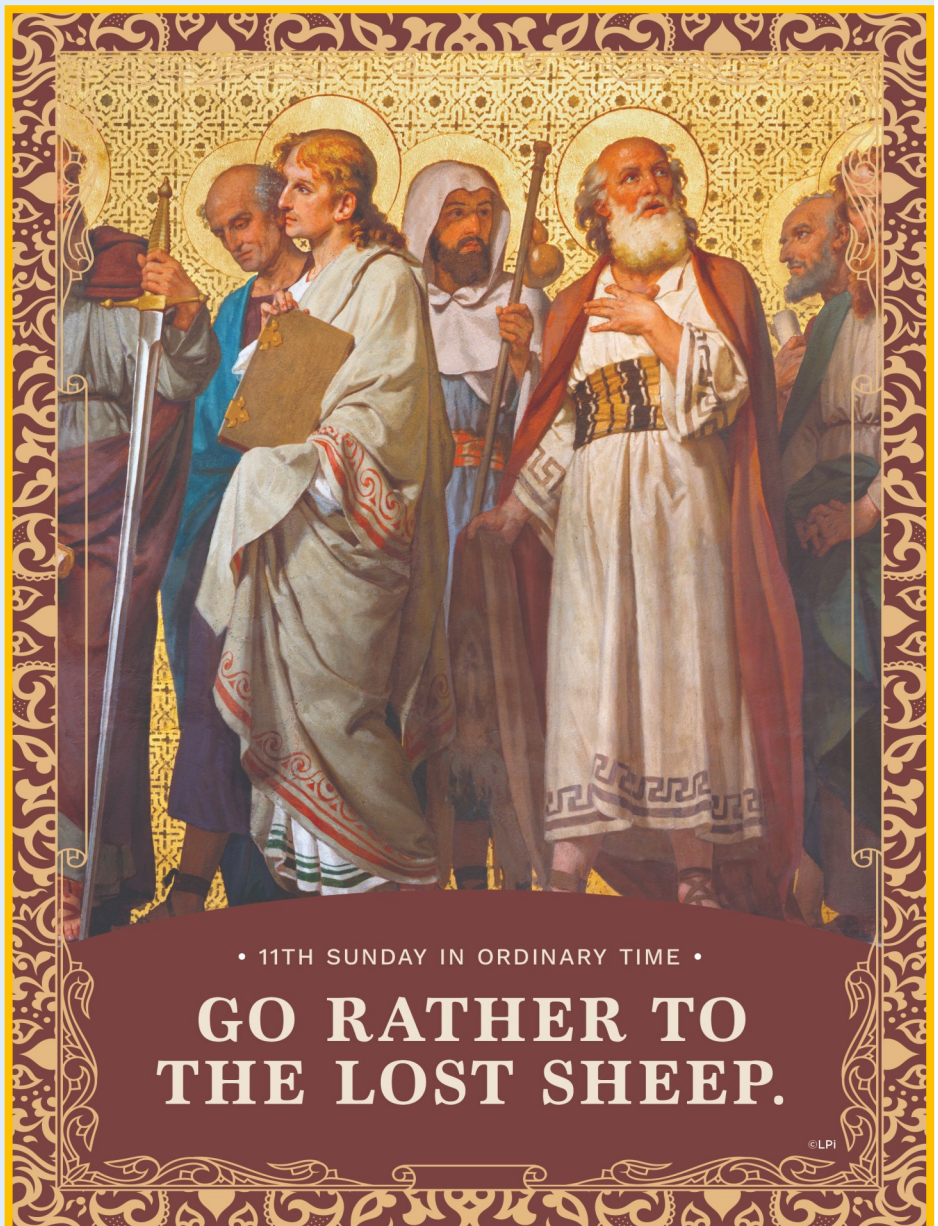

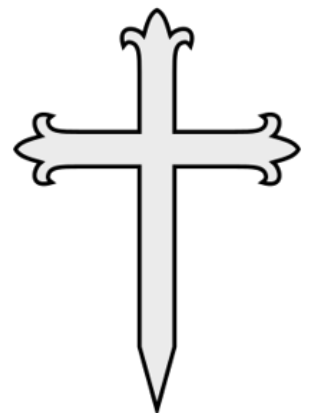
2026 Columbiette Officer Installation

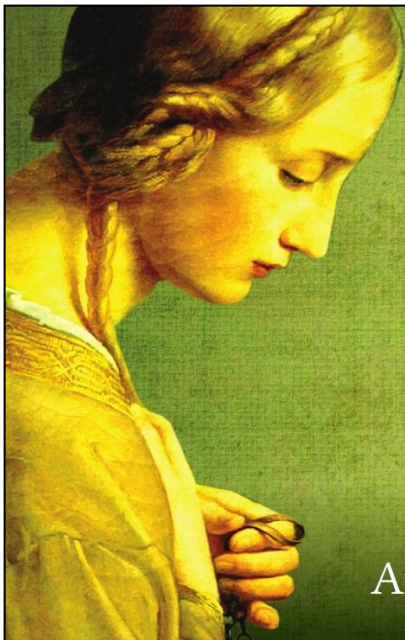
