

A Moment of Hope - This is an evangelical, Christian outreach to women arriving at Columbia's abortion facility, Planned Parenthood. They train, equip, and mobilize Christian believers to be peaceful, prayerful, law-abiding messengers of gospel-centered hope to save lives from abortion



Lighthouse for Life - This organization fights to eradicate human trafficking by educating our community and empowering survivors. They desire to provide grace and restoration to victims being rescued from trafficking.
