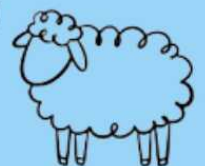

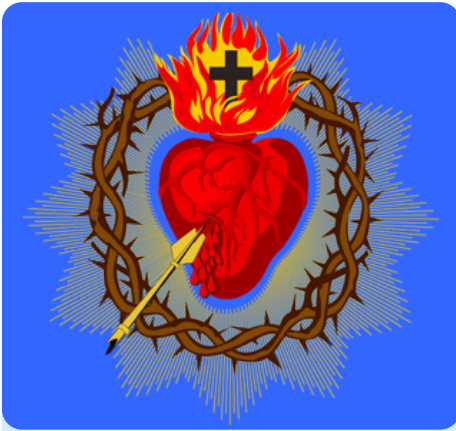

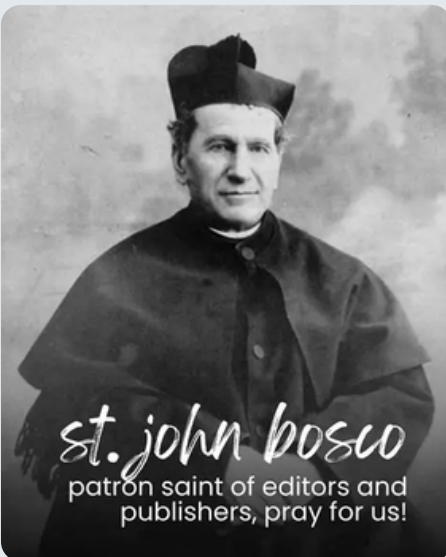
LADIES BIBLE STUDY The Book of Esther

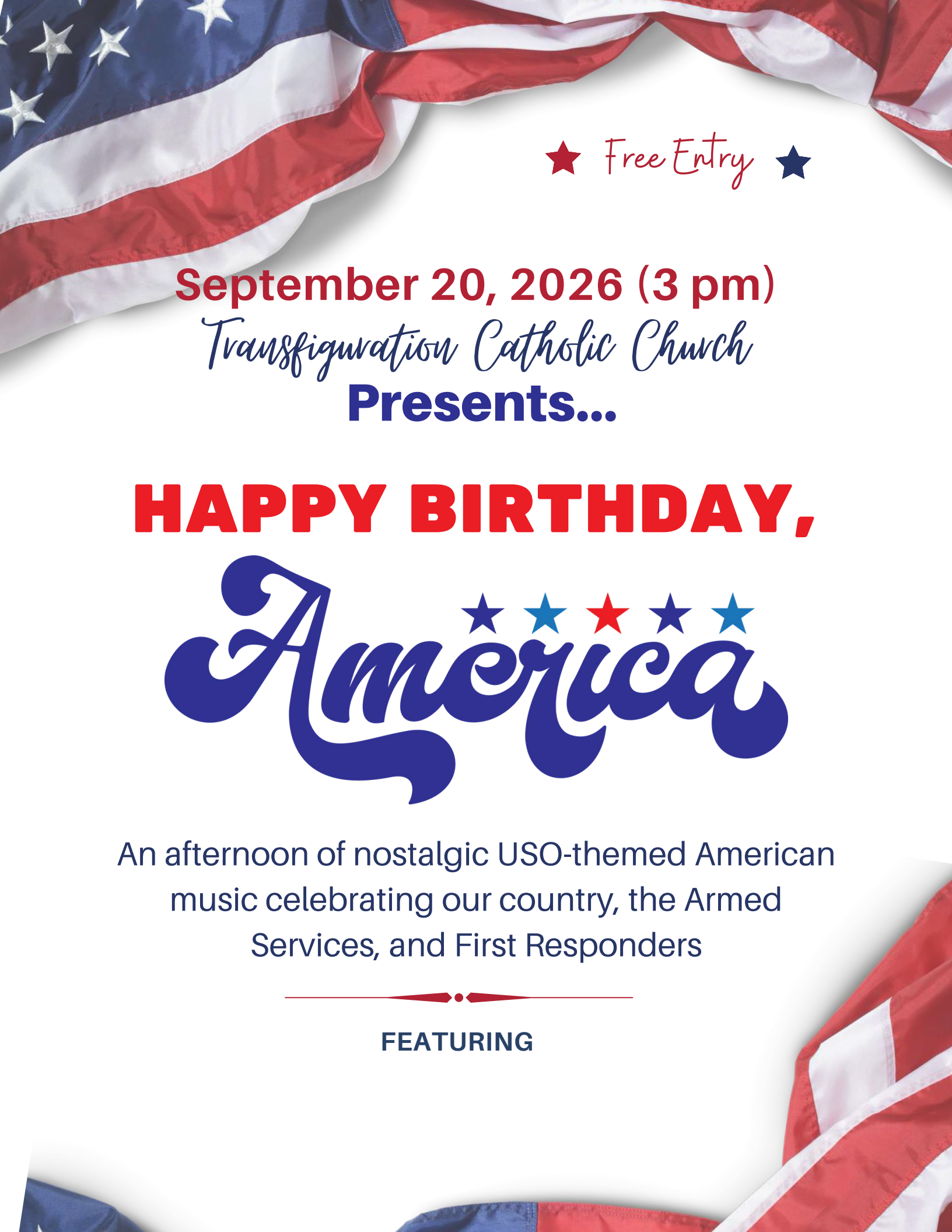
