Columbiettes Supported Charities ~ Spotlight on Midlands Orphan Relief

The charity we are spotlighting this week is Midlands Orphan Relief. With your support, we were able to donate approximately \$1,584 to them from our luncheon proceeds. The mission of Midlands Orphan Relief is to provide support services and aid to meet the needs of South Carolina children identified as at-risk or suffering from abandonment, abuse, and/or neglect.



MOR partners with many agencies and organizations that work together to provide helpful resources for children at critical times in their lives. They receive referrals from The Department of Social Services, schools, counselors, social workers, hospitals, other non-profits, foster parents, and churches.

The main way that MOR helps local at-risk youth and children in foster care is through its distribution center in Columbia. They sort, store, pack, and distribute donations from the community for the children they serve. They provide each referred child a "Care Kit" filled with two weeks' worth of clothing, shoes, new socks & underwear, pajamas, and toiletries as well as school supplies, stuffed animals, and books.

The Sacred Heart of Jesus

June The Month of The Sacred Heart of Jesus

June 2 – Feast of Corpus Christi

Traditionally known as the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, Corpus Christi celebrates the gift of the Eucharist. Harkening back to the Feeding of the Five Thousand, the Wedding at Cana, and the Last Supper, this special day commemorates that with Jesus' Resurrection and Ascension into Heaven, He is always present with us, fully alive in the Eucharist.

June 7 – The Solemnity of the Most Sacred Heart of Jesus

The heart is the symbol of human love. This Catholic devotion honors the Sacred Heart of our Lord, through which was manifested to us God's eternal love for everyone. "God is Love" (1 John 4:8) so in honoring the human expression of that love, especially on the Cross, we honor its Divine Source. The Sacred Heart is the actual heart of Christ, and also indicates His love for humanity.

June 8 – Feast of The Immaculate Heart of The Blessed Virgin Mary

Mary's Immaculate Heart points us to her profound interior life, where she experienced both joys and sorrows, yet remained faithful, as we, too, are called to do. The Servant of God Lúcia de Jesus Rosa dos Santos, one of the Fátima visionaries, said, "The work of our redemption began at the moment when the Word descended from Heaven in order to assume a human body in the womb of Mary. From that moment, and for the next nine months, the Blood of Christ was the Blood of Mary, taken from Her Immaculate Heart; the Heart of Christ was beating in unison with the Heart of Mary." Also, Jesus Himself appeared to Sr. Lucia, saying, "I want My Church to . . . put the devotion to this Immaculate Heart beside the devotion to My Sacred Heart."

June 13 – Saint Anthony of Padua

St Anthony is venerated all over the world as the Patron Saint for lost articles, and is credited with many miracles involving lost people, lost things and even lost spiritual goods.

June 24 – The Nativity of St. John the Baptist

Jesus called John the greatest of all those who had preceded him: "I tell you, among those born of women, no one is greater than John...." But John would have agreed completely with what Jesus added: "[Y]et the least in the kingdom of God is greater than he" (Luke 7:28). John spent his time in the desert, an ascetic. He began to announce the coming of the Kingdom, and to call everyone to a fundamental reformation of life. His purpose was to prepare the way for Jesus.

June 28 – Saint Irenaeus, Bishop and Martyr

Patron Saint of those who work for the unity of the Eastern and Western Churches Invoked against Christological heresies, and by apologists and catechists Declared a Doctor of the Church (Doctor of Unity) by Pope Francis in 2022

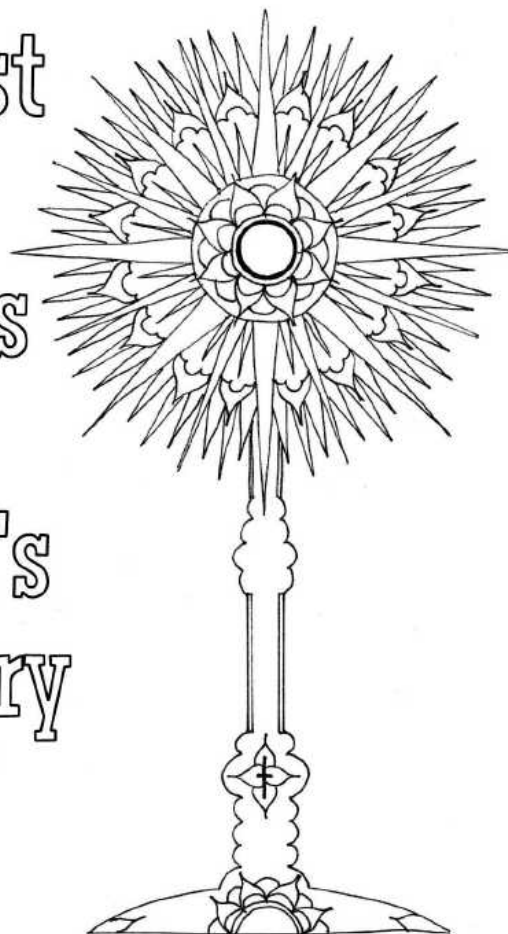

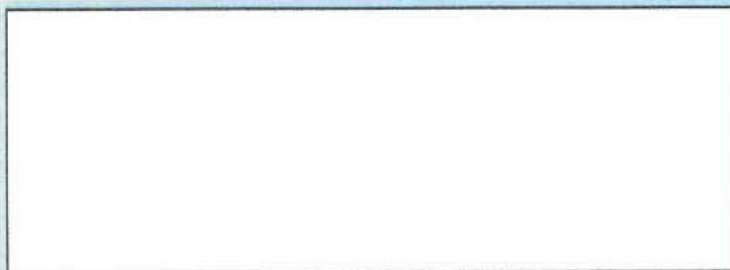
