

## Catechism in a Year Discussion Groups

Last Week's Highlight:

345 The sabbath--the end of the work of the six days. The sacred text says that "on the seventh day God finished his work which he had done", that the "heavens and the earth were finished," and that God, "rested" on this day and sanctified and blessed it.

349 The eighth day. But for us a new day has dawned: the day of Christ's Resurrection. The seventh day completes the first creation. The eighth day begins the new creation. Thus, the work of creation culminates in the greater work of redemption. The first creation finds its meaning and its summit in the new creation in Christ, the splendor of which surpasses that of the first creation. (Bold print added for emphasis)






