


Catechism in a Year Discussion Groups



Dear Parish Family,

As we begin the inaugural year of the Catholic Appeal of South Carolina (formerly, the Bishops Annual Appeal), I encourage your sacrificial support as we join in this effort with Catholics throughout our state. Every day, our diocesan-wide ministries offer care to the poor and disadvantaged, educate our youth and adults, and support the clergy and religious that are serving in every corner of South Carolina. The funds they need to do this come in large part from the money raised by the Catholic Appeal of South Carolina. 


