Catechism in a Year Discussion Groups

Last Week's Highlight:

What does the word liturgy mean?

1069 The word "liturgy" originally meant a "public work" or a "service in the name of/on behalf of the people." In Christian tradition it means the participation of the People of God in "the work of God." Through the liturgy Christ, our redeemer and high priest, continues the work of our redemption in, with, and through his Church.

1070 In the New Testament the word "liturgy" refers not only to the celebration of divine worship but also to the proclamation of the Gospel and to active charity. In all of these situations it is a question of the service of God and neighbor. In a liturgical celebration the Church is servant in the image of her Lord, the one "leitourgos"; she shares in Christ's priesthood (worship), which is both prophetic (proclamation) and kingly (service of charity).

Join your fellow parishioners as we read the Catechism and discuss what we are learning. You can jump in at any time. Here are our upcoming meetings:





Dear Parishioners,

At this time of year, I usually ask your help with Bags for Badges to support our local law enforcement. However, because food prices have gone up and deputies' salaries have not, they are having a great bit of difficulty having dinner. Restaurants used to give them a free meal if they were in uniform and on duty. Now, they are working 12 hour shifts and some places are giving them free drinks, but not as many as before.

To show our support of our law enforcement, Deacon John and I are asking that you consider making a donation for us to purchase restaurant gift cards to help the deputies have meals while they are working. **There are two ways you can help out:**

- 1. You can purchase a gift card from one of the restaurants listed below and put it in an envelope marked "Dinner for Deputies" and place it in the collection basket during Mass or drop it by the parish office. Or...
- 2. You can make a monetary donation (checks made payable to Columbiettes 13713) and we will purchase gift cards in bulk through the RaiseRight Program—this is the preferred method.

All donations (gift cards, cash, or checks) must be to the parish office by Sunday, June 25, 2023.

As we celebrate Memorial Day and Fourth of July, let us think about and pray for the men and women that defend our communities and keep us safe. Thank you for your consideration and generosity.


