Time to Save with Tax Rebates and Credits

The Inflation Reduction Act of 2022 (IRA) includes tax credits and rebates for new heating and cooling equipment, energy-efficiency home improvements, and more. If you have been putting off making a change to your HVAC system, these new tax incentives might be the sign you needed - it's time.

DON'T FORGET: New Tax Incentives Available for Energy Efficient Upgrades

Have you been thinking about upgrading your heating or cooling systems this year? With credits and other rebates available, there has never been a better time to do it.


In our Fall 2022 Maximum Comfort newsletter, we explained the new efficiency standards and minimum efficiency levels required for all air conditioners and heat pumps manufactured after January 1, 2023. The good news is that the minimum efficiency level has increased by roughly 7%. In the North Region, including Pennsylvania and New Jersey, contractors can continue to install lower-efficiency systems that were produced before the deadline. In the Southeast Region, which includes Maryland and Delaware, all installations after January 1 must meet the new energy standards.

Also starting in January 2023, homeowners can earn tax incentives for energy-efficient upgrades made to their homes through the Inflation Reduction Act (IRA).

TAX CREDITS FOR AIR-SOURCE HEAT PUMPS AND CENTRAL AIR CONDITIONERS

Tax incentives are included in the IRA to help offset costs for homeowners who make the proper energy efficiency upgrades to their homes. When you combine these IRA tax credits and the money you will save on monthly energy bills with a new heating or cooling system, it will pay for itself in no time.

Homeowners can claim a tax credit of 30% of the project cost: \$2,000 maximum for new air-source heat pumps, \$1,200 maximum credit for ducted central air conditioners*
(Must meet or exceed efficiency requirements.)



WHOLE HOME EFFICIENCY REBATES

The IRA also includes whole-home energy efficiency rebates of up to \$8,000 for upgrades and efficiency projects that provide proven energy savings. Each state will be responsible for managing the rebate program and authorization of projects to qualify. Unfortunately, these rebates are not yet available; the Department of Energy is still developing the requirements and documentation to provide direction to states, tax professionals, and home service providers. Guidance is anticipated later this year, and we hope to be able to help you qualify for these rebates by next fall.
